

1. PM Modi launched Jan Samarth Portal, now people will get loan easily, know how?



Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Monday inaugurated the Iconic Week celebrations of the Ministry of Finance and Corporate Affairs. Along with this, PM Modi launched the Jan Samarth Portal for the Prime Minister's credit-linked government schemes and also released a new series of coins.

Objective of Jan Samarth Portal

The main objective of this portal is to make the access of all the schemes easier and easier through digital means by bringing all the schemes on one platform for the citizens. This portal ensures coverage of all linked plans.

This means that now you can get important information related to 13 important credit-linked guarantee schemes related to Mudra loan, startup, agriculture or education loan of the Government of India on a single government portal.

Launching the Jansamarth Portal, Prime Minister
Narendra Modi said, "Now through Jansamarth Portal,
the youth of the country, the middle class have got a big
platform for end-to-end delivery and now it will be easy
to take loans. At least If procedures are in place, it is
also natural that more and more people will come
forward to take loans. Initially, the Finance Ministry has
decided to link 13 government credit linked guarantee

2. Dr. Mansukh Mandaviya releases 4th State Food Safety Index on World Food Safety Day



Union Health Minister Mansukh Mandaviya on Tuesday released the fourth State Food Safety Index of the Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) on the occasion of World Food Safety Day.

Mandaviya launched various innovative initiatives by FSSAI, including Eat Right Research Awards and Grants - Phase II, Eat Right Creativity Challenge - Phase III (a school level competition), Logo for Ayurveda Diet.

The State Food Security Index has been released to measure the performance of states on five parameters of food security. SFSI was launched from 2018-19 with an objective to bring about a competitive and positive change in the food security ecosystem in the country. The index will help in providing safe and nutritious food to the people.

On this occasion, Mandaviya emphasized that nation and nutrition are closely related and for a prosperous India, we need a healthy India and for a healthy India, we need healthy citizens. Mandaviya further said that the government is dedicated to ensure health security for every citizen of the country and for this it is focusing on primary, secondary and tertiary health care fronts.

He said, "It is important to note that states have an important role to play in ensuring food security and healthy food practices. It is the need of the hour that we come together to ensure a healthy nation." -Books that advocate innovative recipes about oil-free cooking and sugar-free desserts.

3. India finished second with 12 medals in the Bolat Turlikhanov Cup Wrestling



In the Bolat Turlykhanov Cup wrestling competition in Kazakhstan, India finished second with 12 medals. This includes a total of six gold, one silver and five bronze medals.

Of India's six gold medals, five medals were won by women participants. Iran topped the medal tally with 14 medals.

Sarita Mor won the gold medal in the 59 kg weight category, while Manisha bagged her maiden gold medal in the seniors in the 65 kg weight category.

Mansi Ahlawat 57 and Sakshi Malik won gold medals in the 62 kg weight category. Divya Kakran also won gold in 68kg.

Bipasha won silver in 72kg and Pooja Sihag in 76kg and Sushma Shokeen won bronze in 55kg.

In the men's section, Aman Sehrawat won the gold medal in the 57 kg weight category. At the same time, Bajrang Punia in 65 kg, Mohit Grewal in 125 kg and Neeraj in 63 kg won bronze medals.

4. Scindia launches National Aero Sports Policy to make India a top air sports hub by 2030



New Delhi, 07 June. Civil Aviation Minister Jyotiraditya Scindia announced the National Air Sports Policy-2022 for the first time in New Delhi today. The objective of this policy is to include India among the leading air sports countries by the year 2030.

Through this policy, 11 air sports including aerobatics, ballooning, gliding, parachuting, powered aircraft and rotorcraft will be promoted.

Speaking on the occasion, Mr Scindia said that this policy will create a strong ecosystem of aerial sports activities in the country. He said that this sector would help in the creation of one lakh jobs and in the coming years the revenue would increase from the present Rs 100 crore to Rs 10 thousand crore.

Shri Scindia said that through this policy domestic manufacturing of aerial sports equipment will be encouraged. He informed that Air Sports Federation of India has been formed which will oversee all aspects of these sports.

5. PM to inaugurate Biotech Startup Exhibition 2022 on June 9



Prime Minister Narendra Modi will inaugurate the Biotech Startup Exhibition-2022 at Pragati Maidan in New Delhi tomorrow. Shri Modi will also address a public meeting on this occasion.

The two-day exhibition is being organized by the Department of Biotechnology and the Biotechnology Research Assistance Council. The theme of the exhibition, organized to commemorate the ten years of the Council, is 'Biotech Startup Innovation: For Self-reliant India'.

The exhibition will bring together entrepreneurs, investors, industrialists, scientists, researchers, bioincubators, manufacturers, regulators and government officials on one platform. About three hundred stalls have been set up, showcasing the application of biotechnology in various fields like health care, genomics, bio-pharma, agriculture, industrial biotechnology, waste-to-wealth, clean energy.

6. Women's cricket player Mithali Raj retires from international cricket



Indian cricketer Mithali Raj has announced her retirement from all forms of international cricket. Mithali Raj on Wednesday issued a statement on Twitter saying that she thanks people for the love they have met during their cricketing career.

Mithali wrote that her cricket career was full of ups and downs and she got to learn a lot during her career spanning 23 years. Mithali has written that like every other journey, this journey too is coming to an end.

Mithali, 39, was honored with the Arjuna Award, Padma Shri and Major Dhyan Chand Khel Ratna Award in her cricketing career. During her cricket career, Mithali was a strong player of the Indian women's cricket team's batting line-up.

Although she could not lead India to victory in the World Cup while being the captain of the women's cricket team. But his cricketing career has been brilliant.

Mithali Raj played 232 ODIs for India in which she scored 7805 runs and averaged 50.68. Mithali Raj made her international debut in June 1999 at the age of 16.

India reached the final of the ICC Women's World Cup in 2017 under Mithali Raj as the captain of the Indian women's cricket team.

Mithali Raj also led India to the final of the ICC Women's World Cup in 2005 under her captaincy.

Mithali Raj scored 2364 runs in 89 T20 matches which is the highest score by any Indian till date.

7. India to participate in world's largest maritime exercise 'Rim of the Pacific'



26 countries of the world including India will participate in the largest international maritime military exercise RIMPAC to be led by America. This military exercise will run from June 27 to August 2 in the Pacific Ocean around the Hawaiian Islands of America and Southern California.

For this, America had earlier invited China as well, but due to its attitude in the South China Sea, it was later excluded from military exercises. China had termed this move of America as unfortunate.

The US Defense Ministry Pentagon said on Thursday, Brazil, Israel, Sri Lanka and Vietnam will participate in RIMPAK for the first time this year. This year's theme is Enable, Friendly and Partnership.

Apart from these countries Australia, Brunei, Canada, Chile, Colombia, France, Germany, Indonesia, Japan, Malaysia, Mexico, Netherlands, New Zealand, Peru, South Korea, Philippines, Singapore, Thailand, Tonga and UK will also participate.

47 warships, five submarines and over 200 aircraft will participate in this year's RIMPAC. Apart from this, 25 thousand soldiers of different countries will also participate in this war exercise.

Long-range Anti-Ship Missile (LRASM), Surface-to-Ship Missile and Naval Strike Missile (NSM) will also be fired in this exercise, which will last for about one and a half months.

This year, for the first time, ground units will also be involved in live firing. The Rim of the Pacific Exercise (RIMPAC) takes place every 2 years in the summer. It is the largest international military exercise in the world. America started it in 1971.

8. Union Home Minister Amit Shah to inaugurate National Institute of Tribal Research



Union Home Minister Amit Shah will inaugurate the newly created National Tribal Research Institute. This building is built in the Indian Institute of Public Administration campus located at ITO Rajghat.

Union Home Minister Amit Shah will inaugurate the National Institute of Tribal Research in Delhi today as part of the 'Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav' celebrations by the Ministry of Tribal Affairs. NTRI will be a premier national level institution and will become a major center for tribal concerns, issues and affairs in the academic, executive and legislative spheres.

According to Amit Shah, this building will make a big contribution to the institutional development in tribal affairs. Under the leadership of Modi ji, this government gave full emphasis in the development of tribal and tribal areas in eight years. The Prime Minister clearly believes that the country cannot develop without bringing tribal society into the mainstream.

During the tenure of Atal Bihari Vajpayee, a separate ministry was formed, then there was an interruption in the middle, but now again there is full emphasis on development, education, health and employment and on bringing equality.

It will collaborate with reputed research institutes, universities, organizations as well as academic bodies and resource centres.

It will oversee projects of research scholars from Tribal Research Institutes (TRIs), Centers of Excellence (CoEs), NFS and set benchmarks for improving the quality of research and training.

9. Boeing and Air Works to conduct heavy maintenance inspection of three P-8I aircraft of Indian Navy



Air Works, an Indian Maintenance, Repair and Overhaul (MRO) company, is partnering with The Boeing Company to conduct heavy maintenance checks on three Indian Navy P-8I long-range maritime patrol aircraft at the Air Works in Hosur. Demonstrates the self-reliant India of the government.

- It significantly expands the scope and size of the MRO in India, demonstrating the commitment of both firms to help India achieve a self-reliant position in aerospace and defence.
- The partnership between Boeing and Air Works has resulted in rapid turnaround and increased operational capability for critical defense platforms in India.
- The relationship began with checks on the P-8I Poseidon aircraft and has since expanded to include checks and MROs on the landing gear of Boeing 737 VVIP aircraft of the Indian Air Force.

10. Two new judges appointed in the Supreme Court, the number of judges in the court increased to 34



The Supreme Court is going to achieve its full potential once again with the appointment of two new judges on

Saturday. With the new judges taking oath early next week, the number of judges in the apex court will be 34. The sanctioned strength of judges in the Supreme Court is only 34.

Chief Justice of India N. The Supreme Court collegium headed by V. Ramana recommended the appointment of Chief Justice of the Gauhati High Court Sudhanshu Dhulia and Justice Jamshed B Pardiwala of the Gujarat High Court as judges in the apex court. had.

The Supreme Court Collegium had sent the recommendation of the judges of the High Courts to the Supreme Court on 5 May. A few hours after this recommendation, the Union Law Ministry announced their appointments by issuing a separate notification.

Both these judges will take the oath of secrecy of their new posts on Monday.
