



1. President Draupadi Murmu inaugurates Water Week - India Water Week in Greater Noida



President Draupadi Murmu has reached Greater Noida to inaugurate India Water Week. During this, Uttar Pradesh Governor Anandiben Patel and Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath welcomed President Murmu. On Monday late evening, CM Yogi Adityanath inaugurated the first data center of Noida.

India Water Week is being inaugurated by President Draupadi Murmu on Tuesday. Governor Anandiben Patel and Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath are in Greater Noida to welcome President Murmu. Under the Ganga Jal Project, drinking water will be supplied to the people of Greater Noida. The budget of this project is Rs 8000 crore and it will ensure 85 cusecs of Ganga water supply to Greater Noida.

Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath, during his twoday visit to Noida, inaugurated a state-of-theart data center built by Hiranandani Group in Greater Noida late on Monday evening. Union Railways, Communications. Minister of Information Electronics and Technology Ashwini Vaishnav and Minister of State for Electronics and Information Technology Rajiv Chandrashekhar were present during the inauguration of the state-of-the-art data centre. The data center was built by Yotta, a Mumbaibased subsidiary of the Hiranandani Group, in early 2021. Government officials said that this is the first data center park in Noida. It is connected by six buildings. The center is spread over an area of 3 lakh square feet and has been built at a cost of ₹5,000 crore.

2. Prime Minister Narendra Modi took part in 'Maangarh Dham Ki Gaurav Gatha'



Prime Minister Narendra Modi is on a visit to Rajasthan today (November 01). Here he took part in the Gaurav Gatha program of Mangarh. During this, while addressing the country, PM Modi said that it is inspiring and pleasant for all of us to come to Mangarh Dham in the 'Amrit Mahotsav' of independence. Mangarh Dham is a reflection of the tenacity, sacrifice, penance and patriotism of the tribal heroes and heroes. This is the common heritage of Rajasthan, Gujarat, Madhya Pradesh and Maharashtra.

PM Modi said that the massacre that took place in Mangarh on November 17, 1913 was the culmination of the brutality of the British rule. 3. Ranipur becomes UP's fourth and country's 53rd Tiger Reserve



Union Environment Minister Bhupendra Yadav has announced that Ranipur Tiger Reserve in Uttar Pradesh has become the 53rd tiger reserve of India. It is located at Ranipur in Chitrakoot district in the state and is the fourth tiger reserve in the state after Dudhwa, Pilibhit and Amangarh. Bhupendra Yadav said that spread over an area of 529.36 sq km (230.32 sq km core area and 299.05 sq km buffer area) the new tiger reserve will strengthen tiger conservation efforts. Ranipur Tiger Reserve located in Bundelkhand region of UP is located just 150 km away from Panna Tiger Reserve in Madhya Pradesh. Tiger, leopard, bear, sambar, spotted deer, chinkara and many birds and reptiles are found in Ranipur Tiger Reserve. The most recent count of tigers in India was done in 2018, according to which, in the country 2, There are 967 tigers and 173 of them are in Uttar Pradesh. In September this year, the Yogi cabinet had approved the creation of a tiger reserve in Bundelkhand to promote tiger conservation in Uttar Pradesh. In a meeting chaired by CM Yogi Adityanath, the Cabinet approved notifying the Ranipur Tiger Reserve under the Wildlife Protection Act 1972. The sanctuary will cover 52,989.863 hectares, which includes 29,958.863 hectares of buffer area and 23.031.00 hectares of core area. It

It was informed by the state government that with the approval of necessary posts, it has also been decided to establish 'Ranipur Tiger Conservation Foundation'. The cabinet has approved the proposal to arrange a lump sum fund of Rs 50 crore for its operation and for administrative control of Ranipur Tiger Reserve. Ranipur Tiger Reserve will come under the 'Project Tiger' scheme of the Government of India once notified.

4. Institute of Higher Education will celebrate 'Indian Language Day' every year on 11th December



The University Grants Commission (UGC) has directed all higher education institutions to observe 'Indian Language Day' on December 11. In a notice, the UGC said that this day is a day to create 'language harmony' and a conducive environment for learning. Following the recommendations of the Indian Language Committee, the Commission has written a letter to the Vice Chancellors and Principals of all Universities and Colleges in this regard. The Indian Language Committee was constituted by the Ministry of Education last year.

Apart from mastering one's mother tongue, there is a need to develop a conducive

environment for learning more and more Indian languages, the letter said. At the same time there is a need to create 'language harmony' to develop an attitude and aptitude to love and enjoy the neighboring language.' It was further stated that learning/speaking any other Indian language should be a pleasant and memorable experience.

In fact, the Bhasha Committee proposed the date of December 11 as 'Indian Language Day' or 'Indian Language Festival', as the day marks the birth anniversary of Subramanya Bharathi, the pioneer of modern Tamil poetry. Subramaniam Bharti wrote songs to encourage patriotism during the freedom movement.

Chamu Krishna Shastri, President of the Language Committee, said, "In order to strengthen multilingualism, encourage people to learn more languages and make people feel unity in diversity, celebrating Indian Language Day and celebrating it as an Indian language festival. I have been recommended to celebrate.

5. Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath Inaugurates North India's First Hyper-Scale Data Center



The importance of data is very high in today's time. In view of this, Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath has given the gift of the country's largest data center. CM Yogi Adityanath on Monday inaugurated the first tower of Yotta Data Center with an investment of Rs 6500 crore located at Knowledge Park Five, Greater Noida.

In the presence of CM, Additional Chief Secretary Arvind Kumar and Noida-Greater Noida Authority CEO Ritu Maheshwari also signed a contract with Yotta Company to invest Rs 39,000 crore in the next five to seven years. Along with this, the foundation stone for the construction of two new towers of the data center was also laid. Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath reached the Yotta Data Center at Knowledge Park Five at around 4.30 pm on Monday evening and the data center in the presence of Union Minister of State for IT, Electronics Skill Development Entrepreneurship Rajiv Chandra Shekhar and Uttar Pradesh Industrial Development Minister Nand Gopal Gupta Nandi and Chief Secretary DS Mishra. was launched.

Speaking on the occasion, the Chief Minister said that the country's leading real estate company Hiranandani Group decided to set up a data center in Uttar Pradesh while moving out of Mumbai for the first time last year. Under Invest UP, the company chose Greater Noida for the data center. He said that a total of six towers are to be constructed in this data center in the next five years, in which an investment of about Rs.39 thousand crore will be made.

6. India's first aqua park to be set up in Arunachal Pradesh



Arunachal Pradesh Fisheries Minister Tage Taki on Monday, 31 October 2022 announced that India's first fish museum in the Northeast will soon be set up in Arunachal Pradesh. The fish museum will be part of India's first 'Aqua Park' which has been approved by the Central Government. The park will be set up at Tarin

(Ziro) in Lower Subansiri district of Arunachal Pradesh.

Tage Taki, while giving information about the first fish museum in the Northeast, also said that three years ago Prime Minister Narendra Modi had announced an integrated aqua park for each state and union territory under the Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana to bring about a blue revolution.

7. Defense Minister Rajnath Singh inaugurates Shyok Setu



Union Defense Minister Rajnath is on a two-day visit to Jammu and Kashmir and Ladakh. On the second day of his visit on Friday, the Defense Minister inaugurated 75 infrastructure projects including Shyok Setu in Leh. DG BRO Lt Gen Rajeev Choudhary was also present with him.

Earlier, Defense Minister Rajnath Singh attended the Shaurya Diwas celebrations in Budgam, Srinagar. Here he said that the saddest thing was when the killing of Kashmiri Pandits forced them to migrate from the valley. When the enlightened section of the society shuts its mouth against injustice, then there is no delay in the downfall of the society. In order to ensure the safety of the public in this area, whenever any action has been taken by the army or the security forces of the state against the terrorists and their helpers, the so called intellectuals of the country have seen the violation of the human rights of the terrorists in that action.

8. 'Lakshmi Bhandar' scheme of West Bengal government gets 'Skoch' award

Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee said that this honor is for her government and about two crore women of the state who have been empowered this scheme. He tweeted that I am proud to announce that government's state welfare scheme 'Lakshmi Bhandar' has received the 'SKOCH' award in the women and child development category.

This scheme was started by the Government of West Bengal in August 2021. The female head of the family gets a grant from the government. In Laxmi Bhandar, Rs.500 is given for general caste category and Rs.1,000 per month for scheduled caste and scheduled tribe category.
