



### 1. World Travel Market 2022 being organized in London



The Ministry of Tourism will participate in the World Travel Market (WTM) 2022 in London from 7-9 November. The event is considered one of the largest international traveling exhibitions. The theme of this year's exhibition is 'The Future of Travel Start Now'. With the country reopening to foreign tourists, after a hiatus of nearly two years, India's participation this year is particularly significant. The country is ready for international tourists after the world's largest vaccination campaign. The tourism ministry statement said that India is participating in WTM 2022 to showcase itself as a preferred destination for tourism. During 2019, the contribution of travel and tourism to India's GDP was 5.19 per cent of the total economy. In 2019, the Indian tourism sector has 79. was responsible for 86 million jobs (direct and indirect employment). The consistent efforts of the central and state governments have helped the tourism industry to recover gradually from the shock of the COVID-19 pandemic to pre-pandemic levels, the statement said. # 2. Pragyananand and PV Nandidha of India won the title in the Asian Continental Chess Championship



Top-seeded Indian Grandmaster R Pragyanand and compatriot PV Nandidha won titles in the open and women's sections respectively at the Asian Continental Chess Championship here on Thursday.

Pragyananand drew with compatriot B Adhiban in a 63-move game in the ninth and final round. and emerged as the clear winners with seven points. The 17-year-old from Chennai had reached the final round with a half-point lead over the rest of the field. He took up the challenge from the veteran Adhiban and shared the honor of winning the top prize. The win also earned Pragyanand a ticket to the next FIDE World Cup. SL Narayanan, Harsh Bharatkoti, Karthik Venkataraman and Shamsiddin Vokhidov, the other players who had a shot at the title, missed out after the draw game. While Narayanan and Vokhidov settled for a draw, Bharatkoti and Venkataraman had to be content with half-and-half points after their game ended in a stalemate. GM SP Sethuraman beat IM Kaustav Chatterjee in 41 moves to join five others with 6.5 points. Better tie-break Harsha Bharatkoti finished second on the basis of scores while Adhiban finished third. Narayanan, Vokhidov, Sethuraman and Venkataraman finished fourth to seventh respectively. In the women's event, WGM Nandidha won her ninth round match against Divya Deshmukh. Finished with 7.5 marks. ## 3. Banega Desh Ka Pehla Double Decker Highway in Noida



There is a preparation to build another expressway on top of the Noida-Greater Noida Expressway. This expressway will start from Mahamaya flyover and will go to zero point. It will be connected with

the elevated road from Chilla to Mahamaya flyover and the approach road from Kalindi Kunj. In such a situation, people coming from Delhi and going to Greater Noida and Yamuna Expressway will be able to come and go without getting stuck in the jam. Right now people are getting stuck in the jam on the Noida-Greater Noida Expressway. In the next one-and-a-half-two years, the pressure of vehicles on the Noida-Greno Expressway will increase after the Jewar airport starts. In such a situation, the traffic situation may worsen during that time. Authority officials claim that this will be the country's first double-decker expressway. He told that work has started on the plan to make it. Officials said that it will be made of six lanes. It will be made about 20 km long. He told that on making it 2000 2500 crore is estimated to be spent. KV Singh, Senior Manager of Noida Authority says that brainstorming has started on the plan to build a double-decker expressway. Soon the approval will be taken by placing the complete proposal in front of the top officials. After getting approval from the top officials, it will be placed in the board meeting. Before this, its DPR will be prepared through the consultant. According to him, in the coming time so much pressure of vehicles will increase on Greno Expressway. Those who have to travel towards Pari Chowk or Yamuna Expressway in Greater Noida will be able to move without getting stuck in the jam.

4. The world's first Vedic clock will be installed in Ujjain



The world's first Vedic clock will be installed at the Jantar Mantar i.e. Jiwaji observatory in Ujjain, Madhya Pradesh, on 22 March next year on Gudi

Padwa i.e. the beginning of the new era. State Higher Education Minister Dr. Mohan Yadav and Mayor Mukesh Tatwal did the Bhoomi Pujan of the tower on which the clock would be installed. This clock tower will be constructed with a cost of Rs. One crore 58 lakh. The clock will be fixed on the principles of Vedic period calculation. It will also synchronize the sunrise at different times in the country and abroad every day. The Vikram Panchang will also be included in the Vedic clock application, which will provide detailed information about planets, yoga, Bhadra, lunar position, constellation, Choghadiya, solar eclipse, lunar eclipse along with information from sunrise to sunset. The Vedic clock can also be seen on mobile through the app. Background graphics of clock include all Jyotirlinga, Navagraha, The zodiac will remain. The construction of the tower will be done by the Municipal Corporation as per the drawingdesign provided by the Ujjain Engineering College. The clock will be installed by Vikramaditya Shodh Peeth. The research bench will also make a mobile app of the watch. This watch will be a great gift not only to Ujjain but to the world. Minister Dr. Mohan Yaday said that telescopes would also be installed on top of the clock tower, so that the astronomical events happening in the night sky could be seen.

# 5. 10% reservation under EWS quota will continue, Supreme Court upholds 103rd amendment of constitution



The Supreme Court has given green signal to EWS reservation. During the hearing, 3 out of 5 judges were in favor of reservation. The Supreme Court has taken this decision for the economically weaker

sections, in which 10 percent reservation is available in educational institutions and government jobs. During the hearing, three out of five judges supported reservation on economic grounds. Justice Maheshwari said that economic reservation is not against the fundamental structure of the Constitution. The 103rd amendment is valid. Justice Bela Trivedi, while agreeing to this decision, said that I agree with the conclusion of Justice Maheshwari. SC/ST/OBC have already got reservation. It cannot be included with the general category. The framers of the constitution had talked about keeping the reservation for a limited time but it continues even after 75 years. At the same time, one of the fivejudge bench, Judge Ravindra Bhat has disagreed on this decision. Ravindra Bhat said that a large part of the population belongs to SC/ST/OBC. Many of them are poor. Therefore, the 103rd amendment is wrong. Justice S Ravindra Bhat has also considered it wrong to give reservation above 50 percent. He said that Articles 15(6) and 16(6) should be repealed. Whereas, Chief Justice Lalit has also opposed reservation on economic grounds. He said that I agree with the decision of Justice Ravindra Bhat. That is, the Supreme Court has upheld the EWS reservation by a majority of 3-2.

## 6. Aruna Sairam honored with Chevalier Award by French Government



Carnatic singer, composer, collaborator, humanist and orator, Aruna Sairam has been honored with the Chevalier de l'Ordre des Arts et des Prizes, the highest honor of the French government. Aruna Sairam has been selected for this award not only for her singing skills, but also for her contribution to the development of Indo-French relations. Aruna Sairam started her classical training under her mother Rajalakshmi Sethuraman. She then became a disciple of renowned singer, Sangeeta Kalanidhi T. Brinda, leading a prolific line of female singers of the Tanjore tradition for more than eight generations. Later, he was mentored by many other masters of our country. Her music erased geographical boundaries when she was the first to incorporate abhanga, a Western Indian musical form, into a traditional, South Indian musical program. 7. Suryakumar Yadav becomes first Indian to score 1000 T20 International runs in a year



Indian cricket team's star batsman Suryakumar Yadav created history in the shortest format of cricket as he completed 35 runs during the team's last group match against Zimbabwe. Suryakumar Yadav has now become the first batsman for India to score 1000 runs in a year in T20 International cricket. No other batsman had done such a feat for India in a year before him. Talking about world cricket, Suryakumar Yadav became the second batsman to score 1000 runs in a year and before him this amazing was the opening batsman of Pakistan cricket team in the year 2021, Mohd. Rizwan did it. Not only this, he also became the first batsman in the world to complete 1000 runs in T20 International cricket in the year 2022.

Suryakumar Yadav played a wonderful innings against Zimbabwe and completed his half-century in just 23 balls and meanwhile 3 sixes and 5 fours. Rooted. In this match, he played an unbeaten 61 off 25 balls and hit 4 sixes and 6 fours. The Indian team had lost 4 wickets in this match despite KL Rahul's half-century innings for 101 runs, but Survakumar again worked to handle the Indian team with his innings and his innings was very useful for the team. On the basis of his innings, India scored 180 runs for 5 wickets in 20 overs. So far in the year 2022, Suryakumar Yadav has scored an average of 44.60 and 186 in 28 innings of 28 matches. He has scored 1026 runs with a strike rate of 54 and is at number one in terms of scoring the most runs. He has scored one century and 9 halfcenturies in 28 innings. While scoring 924 runs in 23 matches, Mohd. Rizwan is at number two.

#### 8. Australian Navy conducts Maritime Partnership Exercise with Indian Navy in Bay of Bengal



A maritime partnership exercise was conducted in the Bay of Bengal from 02 to 03 November 2022 in the participation of Royal Australian Navy (RAN) ships HMAS Adelaide and HMAS Anzac and Indian Navy ships Jalashwa and Kavaratti. The exercise included tactical maneuvers, helicopters. Landings and military operations by water, land and air were involved, indicating a high degree of interoperability between the Indian Navy and the RAN.Royal Australian Navy (RAN) ships HMAS Adelaide and HMAS Anzac visited Visakhapatnam from 30 October to 01 November 2022. It was part of Australia's Indo-Pacific Endeavor 2022 (IPE 22). The Australian Defense Forces were hosted by the Eastern Naval Command. Along with ships from the

## 9. Kishore Kumar Basa became the chairman of the National Memorial Authority



Professor Kishore Kumar Basa has been appointed as the chairman of the National Monuments Authority (NMA). The Department of Culture, Government of India released an official notification in this regard. His term will be for three years. Basa is the Vice-Chancellor of the Maharaja Shriram Chandra Bhanj Dev University in Baripada and also the President of the Indian National Confederation and Academy of Anthropologists (INCAA), Which is the largest anthropological association in India. He had been teaching Archaeological Anthropology and Museum Studies since 1980 and was the former Head of the Department of Anthropology at Utkal University. Received Professor Ghanshyam Das Memorial Gold Medal for First Division in BA History (Hons) Examination. He earned his PhD from the University of London in 1991. He was a Commonwealth Postdoctoral Academic Staff Fellow at the University of Cambridge from 1999-2000 and a recipient of the Indo-French Cultural

Exchange Fellowship in 1997.He was the former director of the Indira Gandhi Rashtriya Manav Sangrahalaya in Bhopal, (Ministry of Culture, Government of India (2004–2008), director of the Indian Museum, Kolkata (2008–2010), and director (additional charge) of the Anthropological Survey of India.
