



1 Prime Minister Narendra Modi will inaugurate the new Parliament House on 28 May 2023



PM Narendra Modi will inaugurate the country's new grand Parliament House built in Delhi. For which grand preparations have been made. The new Parliament House that the country is going to get, is going to be bigger than the previous one. The building area of this new Parliament House will be 17 thousand square meters. The new Parliament House is being constructed on a total of 64,500 square meters of land. It is going to be a four-storey building, which will be completely earthquake resistant. The current Lok Sabha has a seating capacity of 590 MPs, while the new Lok Sabha will have 888 seats. At the same time, seating arrangements will be made for 336 people in the audience gallery. The seating capacity of members in Rajya Sabha is being increased from 280 to 384. During the joint session of both the Houses, more than 1,272 MPs will be able to sit together in the new Lok Sabha.

# 2. Patna becomes first municipal corporation to use CBDC

The digital currency e-rupee was launched by the Patna Municipal Corporation at Hotel Maurya. It was

inaugurated by the Mayor, Deputy Mayor and Municipal Commissioner. This digital currency created by the Reserve Bank of India will be used in the entire Patna Municipal Corporation area. This payment system will be fully adopted in the municipal headquarters Mauryalok complex. Along with this, it will also be used at all zonal and payment counters of Patna Municipal Corporation. Patna is the first Municipal Corporation to use Central Bank Digital Currency (CBDC) in whole of India. At the same time, a workshop was also organized for the councilors. Patna Municipal Corporation is progressing on the path of digital payment. We will continue to take it forward continuously, it is our endeavor to provide facilities to the maximum number of common people from the side of Patna Municipal Corporation.

3. Iran successfully tests ballistic missile 'Khyber' with a range of 2000 km



Iran, an Islamic country located in South-West Asia, has successfully tested a surface-to-surface ballistic missile with a range of 2,000 km. # 6. Indian Army 's Sapta Shakti Command conducted ' Sudarshan Shakti Exercise 2023' on the western border



The Sapta Shakti Command of the Indian Army conducted exercise 'Sudarshan Shakti 2023' along the western borders in Rajasthan and Punjab. Exercise 'Sudarshan Shakti 2023' was designed to drive operational plans in a network-centric environment. Exercised combat power, combat support and logistic support in a coordinated application under all enemy threat areas including gray zone warfare as part of high tempo operations. Integrated use of multipliers such as special forces, drones, tethered drones, The scope and objective of the exercise was accomplished by proactively inducting niche technologies covering key aspects of Electronic Warfare along with LAUTER ammunition. Despite the high temperature, the participating troops displayed exemplary training standards and high morale. The exercise fulfilled the stated objectives of the five pillars of transformation enunciated by Chief of Army Staff General Manoj Pandey in January 2023.

7. USA approves "Paxlovid", the first antiviral pill for the treatment of Kovid for adults



The US Food and Drug Administration on Thursday approved the world's first oral antiviral, paxlovid (nimtrelvir and ritonavir tablets) for the treatment of mild to moderate Covid-19 in adults who are at high risk of developing severe coronavirus, US veterans Paxlovid, manufactured by Pfizer, is the fourth drug and the first oral antiviral pill approved by the USFDA for the treatment of COVID-19 in adults. Until now, Paxlovid was being sold in the US under an Emergency Use Authorization (EUA). Last year, several domestic companies including Cipla, Dr Reddy's, Torrent, Hetero, Biocon, Emcure, Granules India, Glenmark and Sun Pharma signed agreements with the Medicines Patent Pool to manufacture generic drug substances and products. overall,

8. Ireland first country in the world to mandate health warning labeling on alcoholic beverages



Ireland is set to become the first country in the world to introduce legislation mandating health labeling on alcoholic beverages. New legislation signed by Health Minister Stephen Donnelly will require alcoholic drinks to display key information such as calorie content, grams of alcohol, risk of cancer and liver disease. To raise awareness of the health risks associated with alcohol consumption and to enable people to make informed decisions about their drinking habits. The law, which mirrors existing rules for food and beverage

products, will take effect May 22, 2026, giving businesses time to adjust to the new requirements. However, the prospect has raised concerns among winemakers in Italy and citizens in several other EU member states.
