



1. India 's Satluj Jal Vidyut Nigam to start second hydropower project 'Arun 4' in Nepal



Nepal has given permission to India's Sutlej Jal Vidyut Nigam — SJVN to start the second hydroelectric project in Nepal. SJVN is currently developing the 900 MW Arun-3 Hydroelectric Project on the Arun River in eastern Nepal. It is likely to be completed in the year 2024. That the Nepal Investment Board meeting chaired by Prime Minister Pushpa Kamal Dahal Prachanda approved the draft project development agreement. The agreement will be signed with Satluj Jal Vidyut Nigam of India to develop the 669 MW Lower Arun Hydroelectric Project in Eastern Nepal. The project will need the approval of the Council of Ministers of Nepal before it can be implemented. In an earlier meeting of the Nepal Investment Board, an investment of 92 billion 68 crore rupees was approved for this project.

2. Maharashtra government approves gender inclusive tourism policy 'I'



In a bid to empower women in the tourism sector, the Maharashtra cabinet approved the implementation of a 'Gender Inclusive Tourism Policy' named 'I' under the 'Amrit Mahotsav of Independence'. The policy will be implemented through Directorate of Tourism and Maharashtra Tourism Development Corporation in

coordination with various schemes of all concerned departments. That in this policy women entrepreneurship development, infrastructure for women, priority to safety of women tourists, for women tourists Five principles of customized products, discounts and travel and tourism development will be adopted. To provide business and employment opportunities to women in the field of tourism and to provide women tourists with the benefit of safe tourism. Various measures will be taken for this. 10 women owned and operated tourism businesses registered with the Directorate of Tourism in each taluka of the state will be assisted to set up tourism business.

3. Angshumali Rastogi becomes India's representative in the International Civil Aviation Organization



Senior bureaucrat Angshumali Rastogi has been appointed India's representative on the Council of the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) in Montreal, Canada. This information was given by the Ministry of Personnel. Rastogi, a 1995 batch officer of the Indian Railway Service of Mechanical Engineers (IRSME), has been appointed in place of Shefali Juneja for three years. Hemang Jani, Secretary, Capacity Building Commission, has been named Senior Advisor to the Executive Director of the World Bank, Washington DC for three years Sai Venkata Ramana Anil Das will be the Advisor to the Executive Director of the World Bank, Washington DC for three years. He will replace Suresh Yadav. That the Appointments Committee of the Cabinet headed by Prime Minister Narendra Modi has approved 12 appointments to fill up various overseas posts.,

Ajay Yadav has taken over as the Managing Director of Solar Energy Corporation of India Limited (SECI). SECI is the nodal agency of the Central Government for the auction of renewable energy projects. SECI, established in 2011, is a Miniratna Category-I Central Public Sector Enterprise (CPSE), functioning as the primary implementing agency for renewable energy schemes and projects under the Ministry of New and Renewable Energy, Government of India. With over 58 GW of renewable energy (RE) project capacities, SECI has played a significant role in driving the growth of India's renewable energy sector. The corporation has been playing an important role in promoting and facilitating investments in solar power projects, making a significant contribution to the country's sustainable energy goals. Notable achievements of SECI include trading of over 35 billion units (BU) of renewable energy (RE) electricity during the financial year 2022-23,

8. Indian Economy: Magnificent Growth in GDP in 2022-23



India's economy demonstrated significant growth with a GDP growth rate of 6.1% in the January-March quarter of 2022-23. This growth, mainly driven by better performance in the agriculture, manufacturing, mining and construction sectors, contributed to an annual growth rate of 7.2%. The strong growth propelled the Indian economy to reach \$3.3 trillion and set the stage for achieving the ambitious target of \$5 trillion in the coming years. 2022-23 GDP growth: The March 2023 quarter GDP growth rate was recorded at 6.1%, showing a steady expansion from the previous quarters. The growth rates for October-December 2022 and July-September 2022 stood at 4.5% and 6.2%, respectively. Taking into account the cumulative growth in the entire financial year, the economy is projected to grow by 7.2% in 2022-23. This is 9.0 percent of the previous financial year 2021-22. A little less than 1%

growth rate. Comparative growth with China: In the first three months of 2023, China recorded an economic growth rate of 4.5%, highlighting India's relatively high growth trajectory.
