

1. These institutes of India found place in top 500 in QS World University Rankings



The results of Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) World University Rankings 2024 are out. In which many IITs, IISc and universities of India are also included. However, this year IISc Bangalore has gone a long way back from its place. Last year IISc Bangalore had secured 155th rank. While the institute has slipped a lot in the rankings this year, IISc Bangalore has got the 225th rank. At the same time, IIT Bombay was ranked 172 last time, which has improved this time and IIT Bombay has been at number 149. According to the NIRF ranking of the Ministry of Education, IISc Bangalore is the best university in the country and the second best institute for providing higher education. Delhi University and Anna University are among the top 500 universities in the world according to the QS World University Rankings. DU has got 407th rank this time. While Anna University has got 427th rank. Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) Bombay is now ranked first in the country and 149th globally, up from 172nd last year. IIT Delhi moved up to 197th this year. It was ranked 174 in the previous ranking. Three other IITs figure in the list of top 300 globally.

2. Exhibition of UNESCO World Heritage Sites: The Greatness and Cultural Heritage of Banknotes



Indira Gandhi National Center for the Arts (IGNCA) is all set to host an extraordinary exhibition titled "Banking on World Heritage". Curated by Ms. Rukmini Dahanukar, an independent scholar and founder of 'Money Talks', this unique exhibition will showcase banknotes featuring UNESCO listed World Heritage Sites. The exhibition aims to provide a fresh perspective on these cultural treasures and will be held at IGNCA from June 30 to July 9, 2023. The event is significant as it is India's presidency of the G-20 summit, Aligned with the 75th year of India's independence and the 50th year of the UNESCO World Heritage Convention. The exhibition will be inaugurated by the Minister of State for External Affairs and Culture Smt. Meenakshi Lekhi. High commissioners and ambassadors of G-20 countries will be present at the opening ceremony. The theme of the exhibition "Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam" or "One Earth One Family One Future" perfectly encapsulates the outstanding universal values of the World Heritage.

3. India has the second largest network of roads after the United States of America

# 4. Diksha Dagar won the second title in Czech Ladies Open



22-year-old talented golfer Diksha Dagar from Jhajjar, Haryana claimed her second Ladies European Tour (LET) title at the Czech Ladies Open. Diksha, who won her maiden LET title in 2019 and was part of the winning team at the Aramco Team Series in London in 2021, performed brilliantly throughout the tournament. The win is his second individual victory on the LET, and he now has nine top-10 finishes, four of which he has achieved this season. Diksha displayed composure and consistency as he started the final day with a five-shot lead. He shot a final round 69, which included four birdies and just one bogey, to take a four-shot victory. Diksha's solid performance throughout the week included a score of 65 in the second round, Where he displayed his exceptional skills with 13 birdies and an eagle in three rounds. Diksha's road to victory was marked by steady progress and a series of impressive performances. With an overall score of 9-under, she kept her composure in the challenging conditions and ended the tournament as a well-deserved champion. Thailand's Trichat Changlaib shot a 64 on the final day, but early-round struggles prevented her from closing the gap on Diksha.

5. American co-inventor of the lithium-ion battery, John Bannister, passes away



John Bannister Goodenough was an American coinvestor of lithium ion batteries who also won the 2019 Nobel Prize in Chemistry. He was about to turn 101 this July 25 but she passed away almost a month ago. He was the world's oldest Nobel laureate. Stan Whittingham who won the Nobel Prize with John, He initially discovered that lithium could be stored inside a sheet of titanium sulphide. John refined it with Cobalt based cathode to create a product which now has a significant impact on everyone's life and is now the most demanded and needed thing. Along with this, he also made a big contribution in making Random Access Memory i.e. RAM. John was born in Germany and his parents were from America. He did his mathematics studies from Yale University and worked as a meteorologist in the US Army during World War II. He had a wonderful life full of discoveries and he contributed a lot in making many inventions, due to which man became simple today.

# 6. UP government started 'Operation Conviction' against criminals



In UP, the police has started 'Operation Conviction' to punish the criminals within 30 days. Under this, crimes related to POCSO Act, rape, murder, robbery, dacoity, conversion and cow slaughter have been included in 75 cities. Efforts will be made to hold hearings in fast track courts every day so that criminals are punished in less

time. DGP Vijay Kumar said that since 2017, on the instructions of CM Yogi, the police is taking continuous action against criminals and mafia under the policy of zero tolerance. Now every month there will be a review regarding the prosecution. On the basis of this there will be ranking of Police Commissioner and SP. He told that robbery, murder, rape, cow slaughter, Separate lists will now be prepared for cases like religious conversion and POCSO. In Operation Conviction, the charge will frame after three days in such cases. There is a plan to start the trial in 30 days. A file of 20-20 cases will be prepared for this work in all the districts. He said that the gazetted officers would monitor the entire matter. Along with this, a wing will also be formed at the headquarters. who will review it.

7. India's first hydrogen powered train: New hope for pollution free and sustainable transport



In a significant step towards adopting sustainable transport, India is set to launch its first hydrogen powered train. Hydrogen trains, which rely on fuel cells to convert hydrogen and oxygen into electricity, provide a clean and environmentally friendly alternative to conventional diesel trains. This groundbreaking initiative marks a promising progress in India's efforts to reduce carbon emissions and combat pollution. The first hydrogen fueled train in India is about to operate on the Jind-Sonipat route. This strategic choice for the opening route highlights the commitment of the Indian authorities to transform the regional transport network with sustainable alternatives. By launching a hydrogen train in this corridor, India aims to demonstrate the feasibility and benefits of hydrogen technology in a realworld setting. The initial prototype of the hydrogen train in India is expected to have eight bogies. These well-designed coaches will provide comfortable and efficient transport for the passengers. While the first model shows the potential of hydrogen powered trains,

future iterations may see advancements in terms of speed, capacity and additional features.

8. Self Reliance Initiative in Indian Defense Sector by DRDO: Drive for Indigenous Technologies



Defense Research and Development Organization (DRDO) recently unveiled a comprehensive list of 75 technology priority sectors with an aim to boost indigenous defense manufacturing sector in India. This strategic move is expected to encourage innovation, indigenization and self-reliance, thereby putting the country on a trajectory towards advanced military technology design and development. The unveiling of these priority areas, along with the DRDO Technology Vision 2023 document, is a significant milestone in fostering engagement between industry, academia and the defense research establishment. The 'Research Chintan Shivir' organized by DRDO under the guidance of Chief of Defense Staff emphasized on the vital role of indigenous defense technologies for the armed forces. Recognizing the need to reduce dependence on foreign imports, The event highlighted the importance of promoting innovation and self-reliance in defense manufacturing. The DRDO Technology Vision 2023 document serves as a comprehensive guide, listing various technology areas that DRDO laboratories are currently working on.
