



1 Chennai Super Kings beat Gujarat Titans by 5 wickets to win the IPL 2023 title



The final of the 16th season of IPL was played between Gujarat Titans and Chennai Super Kings at the Narendra Modi Stadium in Ahmedabad. In this match, CSK won the toss and decided to bowl first. But, The Gujarat batsmen proved him wrong by scoring 214 runs. Sai Sudarshan played a stormy half-century innings of 96 runs in just 47 balls for Gujarat. That heavy rain started. CSK were given a revised target of 171 runs in 15 overs after the rain stopped. In response, CSK won the match by five wickets on the last ball. This is CSK's fifth title under the captaincy of MS Dhoni. Chennai once again got their opening pair Rituraj Gaikwad (23) and Devon Conway (27) off to a good start. He scored 52 runs in the power play (4 overs). After the dismissals of Gaikwad and Conway, Ajinkya and Shivam Dubey continued to score runs at a brisk pace. Ajinkya scored 27 runs off 13 balls. 2. China sent its 3 astronauts into space from 'Shenzhou 16' vehicle



China successfully launched the Shenzhou-16 manned spacecraft and sent three astronauts, including a civilian, to its space station for a five-month mission. According to the 'China Manned Space Agency' (CMSA), the spacecraft was launched at 9:31 am (China time) from the Jiuquan Satellite Launch Center in northwest China through the 'Long March-2F carrier rocket'. About 10 minutes after launch, Shenzhou-16 separated from the rocket and entered its designated orbit. The crew members are fine and the launch was a complete success. The astronauts are expected to arrive at the station's Tianhe core module, about 400 kilometers above the ground, after a journey of less than seven hours. 3. Telangana achieves 100% coverage under 'Pradhan Mantri Jan Dhan Yojana'

Pradhan Mantri Jan-Dhan Yojana (PMJDY)



Telangana State has achieved a significant milestone in financial inclusion by achieving 100% coverage of Pradhan Mantri Jan Dhan Yojana (PMJDY). PMJDY is a national mission for financial inclusion that aims to provide affordable access to financial services such as banking, savings and deposit accounts, remittances, credit, insurance and pension. It serves as a cornerstone for people-centric economic initiatives including Direct Benefit Transfers (DBT), COVID-19 financial assistance, increased wages under PM-KISAN and Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGA). The primary objective of PMJDY is to ensure that every adult in India has a bank account, which facilitates their participation in the formal financial system. All accounts opened under PMJDY in Telangana are online accounts integrated into the core banking system of banks,

4. Justice Augustine George Masih sworn in as Chief Justice of Rajasthan High Court



Justice Augustine George Masih was sworn in as the Chief Justice of the Rajasthan High Court on Tuesday. The oath-taking ceremony was held at Raj Bhavan at 4.30 pm. During this, Governor Kalraj Mishra administered the oath to the new CJ Augustine George Masih. Chief Justice Augustine George Masih took the oath in the English language. Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot and other veterans were present. Justice Masih was born on March 12, 1963 in Ropar, Punjab. She did her early schooling at Nascent Mary Convent School, Kasauli (HP) and then completed her schooling from Saifuddin Tahir High School, Aligarh. He received education from Aligarh Muslim University Aligarh. The Assistant Advocate General, Deputy Advocate General, He has also held the posts of Additional Advocate General. On 10 July 2008, he was appointed as an additional judge in the Punjab-Haryana High Court. The post of Chief Justice in the Rajasthan High Court was lying vacant after the appointment of the then CJ Pankaj Mitthal as a judge in the Supreme Court.

5. CAG of India Girish Chandra Murmu appointed as external auditor of World Health Organization _



Comptroller and Auditor General (CAG) of India Girish Chandra Murmu has been entrusted with the responsibility as external auditor of International Labor Organization (ILO), Geneva for 4 years. He has been elected as the External Auditor of Geneva for a term of 4 years from 2024 to 2027. Girish Chandra Murmu will get to take over from the current external auditor of ILO, the Supreme Audit Institution of the Philippines. The appointment of the CAG is enhancing its high standards, global audit experience and strong national credibility with the international community as well. Bids were invited from the Supreme Audit Institutions (SAI). In which on the basis of better technical experience and other criteria, ILO has selected 3 Apex Audit Institutions (India, Canada and United Kingdom).

6. If you invest more than 10 lakhs in Small Saving Scheme, you will have to give income proof



The central government has now made it mandatory to give income proof for investing more than Rs 10 lakh in post office savings schemes. All investments in post office schemes have been brought under strict KYC and PMLA norms to prevent misuse for activities like terrorist financing and money laundering. According to the circular issued by the Department of Posts, customers are being classified on the basis of risk. Apart from KYC, high risk customers will also have to submit income proof documents. Customers whose total deposits in all their accounts do not exceed Rs 50,000 will be placed in the low risk category. Customers whose total balance in all their accounts is more than Rs 50,000 and less than Rs 10 lakh will be placed in the medium risk category;

7. Maharashtra CM names Bandra-Versova sea route as 'Veer Savarkar Bandra-Versova Sagari Setu'



Maharashtra government has made big announcement on the occasion of Savarkar Jayanti. That now the Bandra-Versova Sea-Link will be known as Veer Savarkar. Savarkar has an important place in the politics of Maharashtra. The government has decided to name the Bandra-Versova sea bridge after Karan Veer Savarkar. It has been decided to give Veer Savarkar Bravery Award to people who have done remarkable work in different fields. Right now only 7 percent of this sea link has been built, while its construction is going on since 2018. Shinde also said that 'Swatantryaveer Savarkar Gallantry Award' will also be given on the lines of Central Government's Gallantry Award. With the formation of Sea Link, the distance between Bandra and Versova can be covered in 20 to 25 minutes. At present it takes one and a half to two hours. Cooperation for information sharing, institutional framework to combat corruption and mutual legal assistance issues were discussed.
