1. Tamil Nadu CM inaugurates registration camp for ap plicants to avail Rs 1,000 monthly assistance scheme

Around 35,923 camps to be organized across the state for the registration process. The first phase of this registration camp for Dharmapuri district will be organized from July 24 to August 4, with an aim to cover 2,21,484 ration card holders.

2. Max Verstappen wins Hungarian GP to give Red Bull 12th consecutive victory



Red Bull's Max Verstappen wrapped up victory over Lando Norris and Sergio Pérez at the Hungarian Grand Prix with another dominant performance. With the win, the defending double world champion took his seventh consecutive victory and Red Bull's 12th in a row – breaking McLaren's long-standing record. With his astonishing score already surpassing the 11 McLaren achieved with Ayrton Senna and Alain Prost during the 1988 season, it ensures Red Bull will extend their perfect winning streak for the 2023 season and set a new overall milestone in terms of consecutive race wins. Verstappen overtook Mercedes rival Lewis Hamilton at the start, then took the lead and confidently held off the chase group to take a lights-toflag victory, This put more distance between him and teammate Pérez in the drivers' position. Verstappen easily passed Norris to the finish line, while Pérez – one of just two drivers along with George Russell to run for a long period of time on hard tires in the first stint – moved from ninth to third with another strong comeback. Norris was initially behind fellow McLaren driver Oscar Piastre, but recovered at the start of the pit stops.

Government of India launched a pioneering "Credit Guarantee Scheme " for the livestock sector with an aim to revive the rural economy and empower the Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs).has started. The Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying (DAHD) has set up a Credit Guarantee Fund Trust of Rs 750 crore to provide credit guarantee coverage to eligible lending institutions, thereby enabling better access to finance for the disadvantaged livestock sector. The Credit Guarantee Scheme holds substantial significance for the livestock sector and the overall rural economy: The scheme focuses on supporting first generation entrepreneurs and the underprivileged sections of the society, who lack collateral security for their enterprises in the livestock sector. It provides them access to financial assistance and credit facilities. By providing credit guarantee coverage, the scheme encourages investment in dairy and meat processing, animal feed plants, breed improvement technology, waste management, and veterinary vaccine and drug manufacturing facilities.

5. World's most famous hacker Kevin Mitnick passed away at the age of 59



One of the most famous hackers-turned-cyber security consultant Kevin Mitnick passed away at the age of 59 in Las Vegas, United States on July 16. In the 1990s he went on a hacking spree that saw him break into the country's cell network, break into government computer systems, and steal thousands of credit card numbers and data files. There is no evidence that he ever used any of the 20,000 credit card numbers. The government accused him of causing millions of dollars in damages to companies including Motorola, Novell, Nokia and Sun Microsystems by stealing software and altering computer code. Mitnick was first arrested for computer crimes at age 17 for walking into a Pacific Bell office and taking a handful of computer manuals and codes to a digital door lock. For this, He spent a year in a rehabilitation center, deemed a computer hacking addict by a federal judge. He is described by investigators as the "most wanted man in the world". was dubbed as the computer hacker .

6. Sukhu launches 'Empowered Women's Loan Scheme'



Chief Minister Thakur Sukhwinder Singh Sukhu launched the Sashakt Mahila Loan Scheme of the Himachal Pradesh State Cooperative Bank. Speaking on the occasion, Mr. Sukhu said that by providing this loan facility, the bank has empowered the women of the state and freed them from the fear of losing their property in case of failure to repay in difficult times. Under this scheme, women who are permanent residents of Himachal Pradesh will be provided collateral-free loans to set up their own enterprises, start livelihood activities, meet everyday needs and uplift their families. Consumable security free loan is the unique feature of this scheme and under this eligible women applying for the loan do not need property as collateral for the loan amount. She said that by removing the condition of consumable security, women, especially those who do not have valuable assets as collateral for taking loans,

Name of the Bill: Rajasthan Minimum Guaranteed Income Bill 2023 (Rajasthan Minimum Guaranteed Income Bill, 2023) This bill was passed in July 2023. In this, people of 18 years or more in villages and cities have been guaranteed employment for 125 days in a year. Till now, under the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act (MNREGA), there was a provision from the Central Government to provide 100 days of employment only in villages. MNREGA was started in the year 2006 across the country. Now in July 2023, the Rajasthan government has increased the employment by 25 days. Under this bill, elderly, women, disabled, widow and single women will get Rs 1,000 as pension.
