



#### 1. 21 % informal workers left PM Pension Scheme



The Pradhan Mantri Shram Yogi Maan - Dhan (PM -SYM ) scheme, a pension scheme for unorganized workers in India, has seen a large number of subscribers leave the program in less than six months. This trend raised doubts about the viability and sustainability of the scheme . have raised concerns . The number of subscribers to the PM - SYM scheme has come down to 4.43 million as of July 11, which is 1.19 million less than the all-time high of 5.62 million recorded on January 31. The main reasons for this decline are said to be high Inflation and rising cost of living have made it challenging for unorganized workers to continue contributing to the voluntary pension programme. Experts suggest that the persistently high prices have substantially increased the cost of living, leading to the PM - SYM scheme for unorganized workers. It has become difficult to bear the burden of monthly contributions under the scheme. Labor economist KR Shyam Sundar highlighted that these exits could be permanent, with workers returning both their contributions and interest earned on them due to ongoing financial stress caused by high prices are taking

#### 4. South Korean President Yoon Suk Yeol visits Ukraine



South Korean President Yoon Suk Yeol made a surprise visit to Ukraine. His visit is being seen as a show of solidarity with Ukraine facing Russian aggression. According to the office, the President will also visit Poland. This is Yol's first visit to Kiev since Russia invaded Ukraine 17 months ago. Yol also visited the small towns of Bucha and Irpin near Kiev, where civilian bodies were found in the streets and in mass graves after Russian troops were pushed back. He also paid floral tributes at the memorial built in the memory of those who lost their lives in the war. Kim Eun-hye, Yeol's senior media adviser, issued a statement saying the president is also scheduled to hold talks with his Ukrainian counterpart Volodymyr Zelensky later in the day. South Korea is a major US partner and has supported US sanctions against Russia.

5. Gajah Kotha Project launched in Assam



In an effort to reduce the growing Human-Elephant Conflict (HEC) issue, Assam has launched "Gajahkotha" campaign, involving over 1,200 individuals and promoting coexistence. The campaign focuses on HEC-affected villages in eastern Assam, where it aims to educate residents about the behaviour, ecology and cultural significance of elephants in the region, emphasizing the importance of conservation. Led by Aaranyak, a leading wildlife NGO based in Guwahati, in collaboration with the British Asian Trust and the Assam Forest Department and supported by the Darwin Initiative, this initiative reflects their dedication to promoting harmonious coexistence between humans and elephants. So far, the campaign has been organized at various places like Haladhibari, Jaborchuk Kathoni, Gajera, Gajera High School, Ujani Majuli Kherkatiya High School, Pub Majuli Kherkatiya High School, Jaborchuk has taken place in Basa and Jopanchuk in Majuli. Aranyak has collaborated with various local organizations to actively engage community members and nurture future advocates in each area affected by Human-Elephant Conflict (HEC). Betel leaves, commonly known as 'vetrilai', are mentioned in Marco Polo's 13th century book 'The Venetian'. Thoothukudi district officials told IANS that several ancient stone inscriptions reveal the ancient prosperity and importance of Athur Vettrilai in Tamil culture. Sources in the Thoothukudi district administration told IANS that steps are being taken to market the GI tag of Athur betel nut across the country as well as in international markets. 7. Adani Group launches India's first international power project

Ultra super critical power plant in Godda, Jharkhand has started with full load. This will supply electricity to Bangladesh. Adani Group Chairman Gautam Adani met Bangladesh Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina in this regard. Adani Power has set up a 1,600 MW thermal power plant at Godda in Jharkhand to supply the generated power to Bangladesh Power Development Board (BPDB) through a dedicated transmission

line. Adani Power Jharkhand Limited (APJL), a wholly-owned subsidiary of Adani Power Limited, on 26 June conducted the commercial operation of the second unit of its 2 X 800 MW Godda Ultra-Super Critical Thermal Power Plant (Godda USCTPP) in Godda district of Jharkhand. The target is achieved in the stipulated date.

## 8. Vande Bharat Express: First semi-high speed train of Indian Railways



Vande Bharat Express is a semi-high speed train service operated by the Indian Railways.
