



1. I. T. Delhi 's campus will be set up in Abu Dhabi , UAE



A Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) has been signed between the Ministry of Education and Abu Dhabi Department of Education and Knowledge (ADEK) and Indian Institute of Technology Delhi (IIT Delhi) to set up the first campus of IIT Delhi in Abu Dhabi . This Memorandum of Understanding It was signed in the presence of His Highness Sheikh Mohamed bin Zayed Al Nahyan, President of the United Arab Emirates and Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi . The MoU was signed by HE Mubarak Hamad Al Mhairi, Under-Secretary of ADEK, Mr. Sanjay Sudhir, Ambassador of India to UAE And signed by Professor Rangan Banerjee, Director, Indian Institute of Technology Delhi. Complementing the ongoing United Arab Emirates -India Comprehensive Economic Partnership Agreement (CEPA), this MoU promotes academic excellence, innovation, knowledge sharing and human capital. reflects the shared vision of both countries to prioritize investment in as the basis for future prosperity and enablers of long - term economic growth and sustainable development.

2. Manoj Ahuja launched a new campaign called BHARAT for banks under Agri Infra Fund



Agriculture Secretary, Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare, Manoj Ahuja launched a new campaign for banks under Agri Infra Fund named Bharat (Banks Heralding Accelerated Rural and Agricultural Transformation) . The campaign will end on July 15 with a target of raising Rs 7,200 crore . From 2023 to 15 August 2023 will last for one month . The launch event took place through a video conferencing, which was attended by over 100 participants including Managing Directors / Chairmen, EDs, Regional Rural Banks, Small Finance Banks, NBFCs and selected public and private sector co - operative banks . More banking officers participated . Samuel Praveen Kumar , Joint Secretary , Agriculture Infrastructure Fund (AIF) highlighted the progress made under the Agri - Infra Fund scheme, which has created over 31,850 agriculture infrastructure in the country with a loan amount of Rs 24,750 crore. The framework is done by projects. The total outlay of this scheme is Rs 42,000. Bank officials made several suggestions to take AIF to new heights. 3. Nigeria 's President declares state of emergency to c urb food shortages and rising prices



Nigerian President Tinubu Balljari has declared a state of emergency due to the food crisis . The country had declared a state of emergency due to rising food prices and shortages . This state of emergency will allow the government to work towards improving food security and supply . By declaring a state of emergency , Nigeria

would work towards clearing farmland to reduce food inflation and forests to increase agricultural production. The President also announced that the money that would be used by removing the fuel subsidy would be used for farmers. Will be done in providing fertilizers and grains. When President Tinubu took office in May 2023, he removed fuel subsidies, which increased prices by 200 percent . However , the Tinubu administration has defended the move and called it " essential". The poor population of the country is also being given \$ 10 every month for six months . A United Nations report in January said that 25 million people in Nigeria were at risk of food insecurity this year. According to a Nigerian website, more than 350 farmers were abducted or killed in the country in the year up to June 2022.

4. India's forex reserves cross \$596.280 billion: RBI data analysis



According to the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) data, India's foreign exchange reserves have increased by \$ 1.229 billion to total \$ 596.280 billion. This marked a near two-month high and a second consecutive weekly increase in stockpiles. The increase in foreign exchange reserves was mainly driven by an increase in foreign currency assets (FCAs) and gold reserves, while special drawing rights (SDRs) saw a marginal decline. According to the Reserve Bank of India data, the foreign exchange reserves increased by \$ 1.229 billion to \$ 596.280 billion in the week ended July 7, 2023. Earlier it had increased by \$ 1.853 billion. Foreign currency assets (FCAs), the largest component of foreign exchange reserves, witnessed a significant increase of \$989 million to reach \$528.968 billion. Gold reserves also increased by \$ 228 million to \$ 44.060 billion, While the reserve position in the International Monetary Fund (SDRs) rose by \$15

million to \$5.017 billion. In contrast, Special Drawing Rights (SDRs) declined marginally by \$4 million to \$18.235 billion in the week ended July 7, 2023.

5. Adani Transmission wins 'Golden Peacock' Environment Management Award 2023



Adani Transmission Limited, the largest listed private sector transmission and distribution company in the country and part of the Adani portfolio, has won the 'Golden Peacock Environment Management Award' from the 'Institute of Directors' in the 'Power Transmission Sector'. This year, an evaluation group comprising environment, health and safety, energy and climate change experts evaluated more than 520 applications. Thereafter, these applications were reviewed by Justice M.N. The review was done by an eminent jury committee headed by Venkatachaliah. Asma Hamza is the first female musician in Sudan and the Arab world. Born in 1932, she grew up in a family that looked like a bubble-laden fruit tree. For almost 70 years this instrument has become an integral part of his life. Many prominent singers rendered his tunes. She is seen as the best ambassador for Sudanese women in the region.

7. President Draupadi Murmu will confer the Bhoomi Samman 2023 award



President Draupadi Murmu will confer "Bhoomi Samman" 2023 to 9 State Secretaries and 68 District Collectors along with their teams on July 18, 2023 at Vigyan Bhawan, New Delhi. He has excelled in achieving completion for key components of the Digital India Land Records Modernization Program (DILRMP) – the core of governance. Union Minister for Rural Development and Panchayati Raj Giriraj Singh said that the event is very important for the state's revenue and registration officials, who will receive "Bhoomi Samman" for the first time in the last 75 years for their outstanding performance . This will be a historic year for institutionalizing "Bhoomi Samman" . He further said

that "Bhoomi Samman "The scheme is a good example of Centre-State cooperative federalism based on trust and partnership, as the ranking system in computerization and digitization of land records is primarily based on reports and inputs from States/UTs.

8. Delhi's IGIA becomes India's first airport with four runways



Delhi's Indira Gandhi International Airport (IGIA) achieved a significant milestone as it became the first airport in India to have four runways. Civil Aviation Minister, Jyotiraditya Scindia inaugurated the airport's fourth runway, increasing its throughput capacity from about 1400-1500 air traffic movements per day to about 2000 air traffic movements per day. The addition of a fourth runway will allow the airport to serve more than 109 million passengers annually. Scindia indicated to open the new terminal of the airport by October this year. The opening of the fourth terminal is expected to further enhance the airport's capacity to handle the growing number of passengers. With new runway and terminal, The Delhi airport will be well equipped to meet the growing demand and is set to become a major international hub. The inauguration of the fourth runway and the first Eastern Cross Taxiway (ECT) marks a landmark day for Indian civil aviation. The ECT connects the northern and southern parts of the airfield, reducing the taxi time for aircraft and allowing passengers to disembark within 12 minutes of landing. This operational efficiency will contribute to the reduction of approximately 55,000 tonnes of CO2 emissions annually.
