



1. India 's first Vedic - theme park ' Ved Van Park ' inaugurated in Noida



India's first Vedic theme park Vedavan has opened in Sector 78 of Noida. It was inaugurated by Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yoqi Adityanath, its construction cost Rs 27 crore. The park has more than 50,000 plants banyan, neem, coconut including kalpavriksha which are mentioned in the Vedas. It hosts laser shows, presents sculptures and wall paintings highlighting the four Vedic literature pieces - Rigveda, Atharvaveda, Yajurveda and Samaveda. The construction of Vedavan began in January 2021 on a piece of land that served as a dump yard. That the park will serve residents of housing societies in Sector 74 to 79 as well as residents of other nearby communities. The theme park is dedicated to Kashyap, Bharadwaj, Gautam, Atri, Vashishtha, It is divided into seven sectors named after sages of the Vedic era including Vishwamitra and Agastya. lt amphitheater and an outdoor gym powered by solar energy. Vedavan is open for visitors daily from 8 am to 9 pm.

2. Odisha government launched 'Mo Jangal Jami Yojana'



Now the government is coming up with a new scheme for the forest dwellers of the country. C. and S. T. It has been done for the tribal communities of the class. Odisha government has recently launched this scheme. With the launch of this scheme, Odisha is going to become the first state in India to recognize individual and forest rights. Mo Jangal Jami Yojana has been created under the Recognized Forest Act of 2006. Mo Jangal Jami Yojana is a scheme launched under the Forest Rights Recognition Act FRA of 2006. About 22.50 percent people of Odisha are going to get the benefit of this scheme because about 22.50 percent people of Odisha. 50 percent of the population is tribal and comes under forest rights. The government has allocated Rs 25 crore for this scheme, which will benefit about 32562 villages. This scheme has been started for all these people. After about 15 years, such a scheme has been started by FRA.

3. Bank of India became the first bank to launch ' Mahila Samman Savings Certificate Scheme'



Public sector lender Bank of India has officially launched Mahila Samman Savings Certificate, 2023. Bank of India is the first bank to operate this scheme in all its branches. It was launched by the MD & CEO of the bank, Rajneesh Karnataka in Mumbai. In this scheme, any girl or woman or guardian on behalf of a minor girl can open Mahila Samman Savings Certificate. The minimum investment in this is Rs.1000 and the account balance is Rs. Maximum amount up to Rs.200000 can be deposited in multiples of Rs.100/-. Any number of accounts can be opened by a single person provided the total amount invested is within the maximum limit of Rs.200000/- and there is a gap of at least three months between the opening of two accounts. In this, you get the interest of 2 years at the same time on maturity. On investing a maximum of Rs 2 lakh at an interest rate of 7.5 per cent, an interest of Rs 320000 will be received after 2 years.

4. RBI appoints P Vasudevan as new executive director



Reserve Bank of India has appointed P Director. Vasudevan as Executive appointment has become effective from July 3, 2023. P.Vasudevan was earlier in charge of the Chief General Manager of Payment and Settlement Systems. P Vasudevan has been working with the Reserve Bank of India for the last three decades. Apart from this, he has also been a faculty member in the Banker's Training College. He has also worked in the regional offices of Bangalore, Mumbai and New Delhi. According to RBI's press release, as Executive Director P. Vasudevan will oversee the Department of Currency Management, Corporate Strategy and Budget Department. 7. Indore Municipal Corporation will be the first urban body to get EPR credit



The Indore Municipal Corporation (IMC) in Madhya Pradesh, India, has created history by becoming the first urban body in the country to receive Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR) credits for recycling banned single-use plastic items. Indore has implemented a complete ban on single use plastic items within the city. Indore has been recognized as India's cleanest city for the sixth consecutive year in the Central Government's annual cleanliness survey. In which the responsibility of the manufacturer for a product is extended to the consumer phase of the product's life cycle. Indore's EPR credit is Rs 8,100, acknowledging IMC's commitment to responsible waste management and sustainable practices. This facility is dedicated to converting confiscated plastic waste into reusable material, Helping to reduce the burden on landfills and promote a circular economy. Indore faces the daily challenge of managing adequate amounts of solid waste, with an average of 1,162 tonnes being generated each day. This includes around 164 tonnes of plastic waste.

8. PM unveils 29 projects in Varanasi



Prime Minister Narendra Modi recently unveiled a series of development projects worth Rs 12,100 crore in the parliamentary constituency Varanasi. These initiatives, spread across various sectors, reflect the government's focus on transforming the city and promoting development in infrastructure, education and other key sectors. One of the important projects inaugurated by PM Modi was the Pandit Deen Dayal Upadhyay Junction-Sone Nagar railway line, which was an important part of the Dedicated Freight Corridor. Built at a cost of over Rs 6,760 crore, this new railway line will enable faster and more efficient movement This will boost economic goods, development in the area. Earlier, PM Modi inaugurated two new Vande Bharat Express trains Gorakhpur, in showcasing the efforts government's to enhance rail connectivity and improve passenger experience.
