1. Indian Meteorological Department (IMD) launched Heat Index



The Indian Meteorological Department (IMD) has come out with the heat index for different regions of the country based on recent tests . The Heat Index provides general guidance and information about the level of discomfort caused by high temperatures in hot regions of India . is designed to provide . By releasing the Heat Index , the IMD aims to provide valuable insights into heat - related conditions to help people better cope with extreme temperatures . Launched by the Indian Meteorological Department (IMD) The purpose of the carried heat index is to provide information about the effect of humidity on high temperatures . It calculates a "feel - like "temperature for humans, which shows how the weather conditions can cause discomfort . Experimental Implementation : Heat Index is currently being implemented on a pilot basis across the country including the state of Andhra Pradesh . It allows to test and refine the accuracy and relevance of the index .

2. Duleep Trophy: A decade long wait for South Zone is over



South Zone won the Duleep Trophy by defeating West Zone by 75 runs in the match played at the M. Chinnaswamy Stadium in Bengaluru . Chasing a target of 298, the West Zone team came out on the last day at 182 for five and were finally bowled out for 222. The win marked South Zone's 14th Duleep Trophy title, and held special significance as a form of redemption. In last year's final, West Zone defeated South Zone by a huge margin of 294 runs. South Zone faced a major hurdle in their title quest in the form of Priyank Panchal, who started his innings on 92. Panchal, however, could only add three runs to yesterday's score and then sent wicketkeeper Ricky Bhui to the pavilion off fast bowler Vidwath Kaverappa.

3. Gaganyaan Human Space Mission: ISRO successfully tests propulsion system of service module



The Indian Space Research Organization successfully flight tested the Service Module Propulsion System (SMPS) of Gaganyaan at ISRO's Propulsion Complex (IPRC) at Mahendragiri, Tamil Nadu. The test consisted of five Liquid Apogee Motors (LAM) (normal rocket engines) each with 440 Newton thrust and 16 Reaction

Control System (RCS) thrusters with 100 Newton thrust each, the national space agency said in a statement. According to ISRO, the goal of the Gaganyaan project is to put three astronauts into orbit at an altitude of 400 kilometers for three days and then land them in the sea within India's maritime boundary to demonstrate the capability of sending humans into space. The Service Module of Gaganyaan is a dualpropellant based propulsion system that meets the criteria for the Orbit Module, for orbit raising, orbit raising, Is able to control, etc., to stay established in the class. The LAM engines with 440 Newton thrust will be the main propulsion force as the vehicle moves into orbit, while the RCS thrusters are capable of correcting any displacement in the vehicle.

4. Jonas Wingeård of Denmark won the 110th edition of the Tour de France



Denmark's Jonas Winggaard of Dutch professional bicycle racing team Jumbo-Visma has won the 110th edition of the Tour de France for the second consecutive year on the Champs-Élysées in Paris, France. The Tour de France (Tour of France) is an annual men's multiple-stage bicycle race held primarily in France. Wingegaard crossed the finish line after the 21day race, 7 minutes 29 seconds ahead of 2020 and 2021 champion Tadej Pogacar of Slovenia. Wingegaard's margin of victory (7 minutes and 29 seconds) was the largest since 2014. The Yatra covers a distance of 3,405 kilometers with eight mountain stages in five mountain ranges. Wingégaard regained control of the race in two

stages in the Alps. Jonas Wingeård Rasmussen (Danish); born: 10 December 1996) is a Danish professional cyclist, Joe cycles for the UCI WorldTeam team Jumbo-Visma. He won the 2022 and 2023 editions of the Tour de France. Wingegaard started out as a youth rider for various Danish teams, making his breakthrough in 2016 as a top rider for the UCI continental team Kologuick-Kult. 5. Tata Steel re-appoints TV Narendran as MD & CEO for 5 years



Tata Steel informed that it has reappointed TV Narendran as MD & CEO for a period of 5 years. The

company said in an exchange filing, "Based on the recommendation of the Nomination and Remuneration Committee, the Board has appointed Mr. Considered and unanimously approved the reappointment of TV Narendran, who is not liable to retire by rotation." The reappointment is subject to the approval of the shareholders of the company. Narendran's current term as CEO and MD will end on September 18, 2023. The company said, "There is no inter-relationship between Mr. Narendran and the other members of the Board." The company said that Narendran has not been prevented from holding the office of director by virtue of any order passed by the Securities and Exchange Board of India or any other such authority.

6. Russia's Sberbank sets up major IT unit in Bengaluru



Sberbank's India branch has been granted permission by the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) to set up an IT unit in Bengaluru. The newly established IT office will serve as Sberbank's in-house data processing centre. Bangalore, India's third largest city, is renowned as the country's foremost scientific and industrial centre. With expertise in aerospace, engineering, electronics industries and IT product development, the city has earned the title of "Silicon Valley of India" . earned the title of The Indian branch of Sberbank has been operating in New Delhi since 2010, offering a wide range of financial services, the new Bengaluru office will focus exclusively on developing information technology. The IT hub will not only cater to the technical requirements of the Indian branch, but will also take charge of building and implementing new digital products for customers. The bank plans to hire 200 IT specialists at its Bengaluru unit, underlining its commitment to spur growth and provide employment opportunities in the region.

7. Justice Ashish Jitendra Desai sworn in as Chief Justice of Kerala High Court



Justice Ashish Jitendra Desai was sworn in as the 38th Chief Justice of the Kerala High Court at a formal ceremony held at the Raj Bhavan. Kerala Governor Arif Mohammed Khan administered the oath of office to the newly appointed Chief Justice, marking the beginning of his tenure. He was previously a judge of the Gujarat High Court and served as the senior-most judge of that court, also temporarily performing the duties of the office of Chief Justice of the Gujarat High Court. His appointment as Chief Justice of the Kerala High Court was recommended by the Supreme Court Collegium on July 6, 2023, after the previous Chief Justice SV Bhatt was levated to the Supreme Court. The appointment was later notified by the Center on July 19, 2023.

8. Revised rules relating to retirement benefits of IAS, IPS, IFOS pensioners



The Central Government has amended the All India Services (Death-cum-Retirement Benefits) Rules 1958 relating to retirement benefits of IAS, IPS (Indian Police Service) and IFO (Indian Forest Service) pensioners. Rule 1958 was amended in Rule 2023 by the Department of Personnel and Training (DOPT). It mainly focuses on retired intelligence security related or organizations. Central Government itself IAS, It reserves the right to take action against IPS and IFos and withhold or withdraw their pension even without reference to the State Government if they are found guilty of serious misconduct or offence. The amended rules state that the decision of the central government on withholding or withdrawing pension "shall be final". In these added rules, 'serious misconduct' includes communication or disclosure of any document or information specified in the Official Secrets Act and 'serious offence' includes any offense related to an offense under the Official Secrets Act. In the All India Services (Death-cum-Retirement Benefits) Rules, 1958 earlier Rule 3(3) stated that the Central Government may withhold or withdraw a pension or any part thereof on a reference to the State Government concerned.
