

1. Shivendra Nath of BSNL next CMD of EPIL

5. OpenAl CEO Sam Altman Launches WorldCoin Crypto Project



OpenAI CEO Sam Altman started the WorldCoin crypto project with two co-founders. Through this project, users will get a verified digital identity and access to financial projects. WorldCoin is a crypto-currency project launched by Sam Altman, CEO of OpenAI, along with Alex Blania and Max Novendstern, with the main objective of providing its users with a private digital identity — a world identity — to register individually. After, where an "orb" imaging device scans the unique


iris pattern of their eye to verify they are "a real and unique person". The orb is a silver sphere that can capture a high-resolution image of the iris, which is unique to each individual. The orb then encrypts the image and sends it back to the blockchain network, where it is matched with the WorldCoin address. The person who scans their eyes receives some WorldCoins as a reward for joining the network.

6. GST collections exceed Rs 1.65 lakh crore in July; Recorded 11% YoY Growth



The Finance Ministry said that the GST collection in the month of July was recorded at Rs 1,65,105 crore. GST collections crossed Rs 1.6 lakh crore for the fifth time since the introduction of the Goods and Services Tax. The revenue for July is 11 per cent more than the GST revenue for the same month last year. Of the gross GST of Rs 1.65 lakh crore collected in July, Rs 29,773 crore is CGST and Rs 37,623 crore is SGST. Rs 85,930 crore is IGST, of which Rs 41,239 crore is collected on import of goods and Cess is Rs 11,779 crore, of which Rs 840 crore is collected on import of goods. The ministry said the government settled Rs 39,785 crore to CGST and Rs 33,188 crore to SGST from IGST. The total revenue of the Center and States in July after regular settlement is Rs 69,558 crore for CGST and Rs 70,811 crore for SGST.

7. ISRO placed Chandrayaan-3 in translunar orbit.



The Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO) announced that Chandrayaan-3 has successfully completed its orbit around the Earth and is currently moving towards the Moon. It said, "ISTRAC (ISRO Telemetry, Tracking and Command Network) carried out a successful perigee-firing. ISRO has placed the spacecraft in the translunar orbit." Chandrayaan-3 successfully orbited the Earth and is now moving fast on its journey to the Moon. Now its final stop will be the Moon's surface where a soft landing will take place. Earth Thirst firing has been done to take Chandrayaan-3 out of its orbit. ISRO has sent the spacecraft into the translunar orbit. Now the spacecraft will be entered into the lunar orbit on August 5. According to ISRO so far All the phases have been successfully completed. Preparations will be made for the soft landing of Chandrayaan-3 on August 23. Chandrayaan-3 started its journey to the moon on July 14.
