



### 1. Diego Godin announces his retirement from professional football



Former Uruguay defender Diego Godin has retired from professional soccer, ending a 20-year career at the age of 37. Godin played in four World Cups and spent most of his club career in Spain, notably at Atlético Madrid from 2010 to 2019. This season, he played in Argentina for Velez Sarsfield. Godin announced his retirement a day after his last appearance for Vélez in a 1-0 loss against Huracan. Godin played in over 600 professional matches and scored 38 goals in his career. He won 10 titles, Which included two Europa League titles. He played for Uruguay in the last four World Cups. Godin won the UEFA Europa League twice with Atlético and the UEFA Europa Super Cup three times - eventually lifting it as club captain in 2018. He also won the Copa del Rey against Real Madrid in 2013 and scored on loan for Atlético in the UEFA Europa Champions League final in 2014, although a successful European Cup victory did not end Godin's Atlético career.

# 2. Severe reduction in sea ice of Antarctica : will have a profound impact on the climate



Antarctica's sea ice extent has been recorded at around 14.2 million square kilometres, which is well below normal for this time. In normal condition, it is 16.7 million square kilometers. Antarctica's sea ice size on July 25 was about 14.2 million square kilometers, while the normal sea ice size for this year should be closer to about 16.7 million square kilometers. Antarctica lost about 2.6 million square kilometers of sea ice over the long-term average observed during the satellite era.

There has been a significant decline in winter sea ice extent since 2015 compared to record highs seen in 2012 to 2014. Higher temperatures in the Northern Hemisphere: Due to the effects of Northern Hemisphere warming, the climate in Antarctica is resulting in a reduction in sea ice cover. Warm air from the north:

#### 3. SBI posts highest ever quarterly profit of ₹ 16,884 crore



State Bank of India (SBI) reported its highest-ever quarterly profit of Rs 16,884 crore in the April-June quarter of 2023-24 - nearly three times more than Rs 6,068 crore in the year-ago period. Buoyed by a sharp decline in bad loans and higher interest income. On a consolidated basis, the bank's net income grew more than two-fold to ₹18,537 crore in the year-ago quarter from ₹7,325 crore a year ago. The total income during this period stood at ₹ 1,32,333 crore, as against ₹ 94,524 crore in the April-June guarter of 2022-23. On a sequential basis, some key figures such as margin and net interest income saw a marginal decline, while loan loss provisions more than doubled, leading SBI shares to fall nearly 3 per cent. Annoyed by this, Chairman Dinesh Khare opened his earnings address by wondering why markets and analysts only focus on sequential numbers.

### 4. Kerala will set up India 's first fisheries Atal Incubation Centre



After receiving a grant of ₹10 crore from NITI Aayog, the Kerala University of Fisheries and Ocean Studies (KUFOS) will set up India's first Atal Incubation Center

(AIC) in fisheries. NITI Aayog, as the premier policy think tank of the Government of India, provided a grant to KUFOS to promote innovation and entrepreneurship in the fisheries sector. The AIC initiative is part of the Atal Innovation Mission, The objective of which is to promote a culture of innovation and entrepreneurship in various industries of the country. Fisheries Atal Incubation Center will act as a focal point to foster innovation and inspire young individuals to create advanced technologies and solutions that will address challenges faced by our marine ecosystem and fishing communities . Its primary objective is to promote progress in the fisheries industry by providing a supportive and encouraging environment for startups and innovative initiatives within the sector. The center will play a key role in creating employment opportunities, creating a conducive environment for startups and entrepreneurs to flourish and succeed.

5. Mark Margolis, famous actor of 'Breaking Bad' passed away



Actor Mark Margolis, best known for Scarface and Breaking Bad, has died at the age of 83. At that time the actor's wife and son were with him. The actor was best known among Breaking Bad fans for playing Hector Teo Salamanca on the hit series and spin-off Better Call Saul. In 2016, he reprized that role as the character's youth. He guest-starred in the second to sixth seasons of AMC's multi-award nominated show, Better Call Saul, from 2022. Mark was also famous for his break-out role of Alberto the Shadow in Scarface. Born in Philadelphia in 1939, Mark moved to New York City at a young age to pursue a career in acting. He started focusing on theater work, Where he played in the Broadway production of Infidel Caesar, based on William Shakespeare's Julius Caesar. He founded a touring theater company called Blue Dome.

6. Pradeep Singh Vaghela of Bharatiya Janata Party resigned from the post of Gujarat General Secretary



Pradeep Singh Vaghela of the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) has resigned from the post of Gujarat General Secretary. After which there has been a stir in the politics of the state. Pradeep is the second powerful leader in the state after state president CR Patil. Pradeep Singh Vaghela was appointed as the General Secretary of the State BJP on 10 August 2016. This announcement has come just a year before the Lok Sabha elections. With elections in mind, the Gujarat BJP recently launched a 'Maha Jansampark Abhiyan' or mass contact programme, in which it organized gatherings of intellectuals and conferences of various business communities, among other things. 7. Reliance ranks 88th in Fortune Global 500 list



Industrialist Mukesh Ambani-led Reliance Industries rose to the 88th rank among Indian companies in the latest Fortune Global 500 list. This is his highest ranking. Reliance got 104th ranking in the year 2022 list which has gone up to 88 in this year's list. In this way, the country's most valuable company Reliance has been able to jump 16 places in a year. At the same time, in the last two years, Reliance has improved a total of 67 places in the list of Fortune Global. The company was ranked 155th in the year 2021 list. Companies on the Fortune Global 500 list are selected based on their total revenue during the fiscal year ending March. A total of

eight Indian companies including Reliance have been given a place in the latest list. The second Indian company in this list is Indian Oil Corporation, which has jumped 48 places to rank 94. Life Insurance Corporation of India (LIC) this time nine places Slipping down to 107th ranking. Other public sector companies - ONGC, BPCL and SBI have also made it to the list. ONGC is ranked 158th in the list, BPCL is ranked 233rd and SBI is ranked 235th.

#### 8. Fitch downgrades US credit rating, know everything



American rating agency Fitch has downgraded America's credit rating. Fitch has downgraded the US credit rating from AAA to AA+, which is worrying for the US. Seeing this, President Biden is shocked because it will have an impact on the global economy. The US currently has a Triple-A rating from Moody's. S&P stripped the US of its AAA in 2011. After this, Fitch has also removed the Triple A rating from America. The AAA or Triple-A rating is the highest rating an agency can give to a country or institution based on its ability to repay debt. This rating indirectly shows how the economic condition of the country or company is. The purpose of rating is to show the economic or financial condition of the borrower. When a rating is decided for a country, the agencies look at economic growth, tax revenue, government spending, Looks at deficit and debt levels. When an investor invests in a country or company, they do this rating analysis. Countries that have a triple A rating are believed to have strong economic conditions. Currently Australia, Denmark, Luxembourg, Netherlands, Germany, Norway, Singapore and Switzerland have Triple-A ratings from all three major rating agencies in the world.
