

1. Anwarul Haq Kakar sworn in as Caretaker Prime Minister of Pakistan



Anwarul Haq Kakar, a prominent ethnic Pushtun leader with close ties to the influential military, has been sworn in as the country's caretaker prime minister. With this appointment, Kakar has been entrusted with the responsibility of leading an impartial administration, overseeing the upcoming general elections and addressing the economic hurdles facing the country. Kar is reputed to be the youngest interim prime minister in the history of Pakistan. President Arif Alvi administered the oath to Anwarul Haque Kakar in a simple ceremony held at Rashtrapati Bhavan. Outgoing Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif and several prominent leaders participated in the event. This moment promoted Kakar to the role of the 8th Interim Prime Minister of Pakistan. Kakar formally resigned from the Senate and the Balochistan Awami Party (BAP). thereby strengthening his commitment to the neutrality demanded by his current position. The Senate Chairman accepted Kakar's resignation in accordance with the mentioned in Clause (1) of Article 64 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan.

2. Monitoring of high altitude areas will increase, Swati Mountain radar included in Indian Army



To strengthen the country's battlefield surveillance and reconnaissance capabilities, the Indian Army has

inducted a lighter and more compact version of the indigenously developed Weapon Locating Radar (WLR-M), called 'Swati Mountain'. The radar system was flagged off by Lt Gen JB Choudhary, Deputy Chief of Army Staff (DCOAS) at a function in Agra, Uttar Pradesh. To enhance surveillance in the high altitude areas of the country, the Indian Army has inducted the Swati Mountain Radar in its mountain surveillance fleet. This radar is capable of detecting and tracking small projectiles in the battlefield taking into account the environmental conditions. Deputy Chief of Army Staff (CD&S) Lt Gen JB Choudhary flagged off the radar system, Which will strengthen the battlefield surveillance capabilities of the army. 4. CSIR-NBRI launches Lotus flower with 108 petals



CSIR-National Botanical Research Institute has launched 'Namoh 108', an improved variety of national flower lotus with 108 petals, at an event in Lucknow. A day before Independence Day, CSIR Director General N. Kalaiselvi launched the flower to dedicate it to the nation as part of NBRI's week-long festival 'One Week One Lab Programme'. The Director also inaugurated a wellness center for CSIR-NBRI employees and planted a sapling. "It is a happy coincidence that 'NAMOH 108' has been dedicated to the nation a day before Independence Day." They said, "Scientists from NBRI were brought from Manipur to do research on this lotus. It is the first Lotus variety to have its genome completely sequenced. This plant will never become extinct or endangered like many of our plants." The institute also released a new variety of aloe vera called NBRI Nihar along with six other products, which are the result of research and development wing of the institute.

5. SEBI reduces the time taken for IPO listing to three days



The Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) took an important step on 09 August 2023 for the benefit of investors and IPO issuers. After the closure of the IPO, the regulator has reduced the deadline for listing of shares in the stock markets to half, ie three days. Presently this time limit is six days. The Securities and Exchange Board of India said in a circular that the new listing deadline will be voluntary for all public issues coming on or after September 1, while it will be mandatory for those coming after December 1. The listing and reduction in trading time will benefit issuers as well as investors. The amount of capital raised by the issuing company through this move She will be able to get him soon. This will make it easier to do business and investors will also get an opportunity to get their investment money and cash faster. According to SEBI, it has been decided to reduce the time taken for listing of shares from 6 working days (T+6 days) to three working days (T+3 days) after the closure of the public issue. Here 't' is the last date of issue closure.


6. Government again increased windfall tax on crude oil and diesel



The central government has made a huge increase in windfall tax on the export of crude oil produced in the country. The government has increased the windfall tax on crude oil to Rs 7,100 per tonne. Along with this, it has been increased to Rs 5.50 per liter on the export of

diesel. The new rates have come into effect from Tuesday. According to a notification issued by the government, the windfall tax on domestically produced crude oil has been increased from Rs 4,250 per tonne to Rs 7,100 per tonne. Special Additional Excise Duty (SAED) on export of diesel has been increased from Re 1 per liter to Rs 5.50 per litre. At the same time, a duty of Rs 2 per liter has come into force on the export of Aviation Turbine Fuel (ATF), but the SAED on petrol will remain zero for now. SAED is also known as Windfall Tax. The government had decided to impose a windfall tax on the production and export of crude oil in the country from July 1, 2022. Which is levied on extraordinary profits of energy companies. It is reviewed every fortnight on the basis of average crude oil prices. In August, the price of crude oil in the international market is at an average of US \$ 86.8 per barrel.

7. Poet-diplomat Abhay K releases latest book 'Monsoon'



Poet-diplomat Abhay launched his new book 'Monsoon' at Kathika Cultural Center in Old Delhi. Singer Ananya Gaur and her team mesmerized the audience with a rendition of monsoon ragas on the occasion. 8. ADB approves \$40.4 million loan for child development, maternal health



Asian Development Bank

The Asian Development Bank (ADB) has approved a \$40.4 million loan to integrate early childhood development (ECD) and maternal mental health in Meghalaya. This is part of ADB's effort to help Meghalaya set up nutrition gardens in Anganwadi Centers (AWCs) for improved dietary diversity and nutritional security. This loan will help Meghalaya ensure that children as young as 6 receive nutritional care for their growth and development. The state government will contribute \$15.27 million to the project. The project will strengthen home-based child care (0-1.5 years old children) and centre-based child care (1.5-6 years old) through daycare (anganwadi) centers in Meghalaya. The project aims to improve access to foster care, Including a component of maternal mental health care and group-based parenting programs to include fathers in care. ADB's assistance will also improve nutrient adequacy by including eggs in the diet of pregnant and lactating women and children aged 0.5-6 years.
