

Ratan Tata, former chairman of the Tata Group, was honored with the Udyog Ratna Award by the Maharashtra government. Maharashtra CM Eknath Shinde along with his two deputy CMs Ajit Pawar and Devendra Fadnavis reached Ratan Tata's residence and honored him with the first Udyog Ratna award. CM Shinde informed that the Udyog Ratna Award has been started by the Government of Maharashtra for the first time. The contribution of Ratan Tata and Tata Group to the country is immense. The Maharashtra government had announced the Maharashtra Udyog Ratna Award to Ratan Tata on July 28 last. 3. BRO starts construction of world's highest road



India's Border Roads Organization (BRO) has started the construction work of the world's highest road. This road is being built in Demchok sector of Ladakh. This strategic road named 'Likru-Mig La-Phukche' will pass through an altitude of 19,400 feet and cross the Umling La Pass to become the highest motorable road in the world. This road is just three kilometers from the Line of Actual Control (LAC). The road construction is being commanded by a five-member team of women engineers under the leadership of Colonel Ponung Doming. The new road will reach an altitude of 19,400 feet at its highest point. When completed, the road will be the world's highest motorable road crossing the Umling La pass. The current highest motorable road in the world has also been constructed by BRO. It may be noted that two years ago, BRO had 19, 024 feet at Umling La in Ladakh, which set a world record by building and blacktopping the world's highest motorable road, which it is all set to break itself. The special thing is that the construction of Likaru-Mig La-Fukche road has been started by an all-women unit of BRO. The five-member team of women engineers, headed by Colonel Ponung Doming, is supervising the road construction. The construction of the Likaru-Mig La-Fukche road begins at a time when the Nyoma Advanced Landing Ground in Ladakh is being upgraded to support combat operations. 5. Adani portfolio outperforms, Q1 FY24 EBITDA up 42% to Rs 23,532 cr



Adani Group's portfolio delivered another outstanding performance with an all-time high quarterly profit

(EBITDA) of Rs 23,532 crore, up 42% year-on-year. June quarter FY24 results compendium for the portfolio of listed companies was released. The core infrastructure and utility platform, which generates stable and assured cash flows, accounted for 86% of the total portfolio EBITDA and stood at INR 20,233 crore. It provides a high degree of stability and multi-decade income predictability and visibility. The strong profitability has resulted in the portfolio enjoying a very strong liquidity position. The cash balance at the end of June 2023 stood at Rs 42,115 crore, up 4.2% from a guarter ago. The success of the incubation story continued under Adani Enterprises. Airports under major incubators, Green Hydrogen and other businesses saw their profits nearly double year over year. With an EBITDA of Rs 1718 crore, these businesses contributed 7% to the portfolio EBITDA. The strong portfolio performance was primarily driven by the renewable energy business under Adani Green, infrastructure businesses under Adani Enterprises and cement businesses under Adani Cement. Adani Green reported an EBITDA of Rs 2,200 crore, a year-on-year growth of 67%.

Streak has played 65 Tests and 189 ODIs in international cricket for Zimbabwe. Streak had colon and liver cancer. His treatment was going on in South Africa. The streak was part of the golden generation of Zimbabwean cricketers between 1997 and 2002. In a career spanning over a decade, he scored a total of

4,933 runs in both the formats. While taking 455 wickets during this wonderful journey. During this, he took 4 wickets in an innings 16 times, While he has done the feat of taking 5 wickets in an innings 7 times. In ODI cricket too, Heath Streak has been a force to be reckoned with with the ball. Streak led the country in the 2000s before resigning in 2004 following a clash with the Zimbabwean board. In 2000, the Zimbabwe Cricket Board appointed Heath Streak as the captain of both the Test and ODI teams.
