



Radhika Iyengar is the author of 'Fire on the Ganga: Life Among the Dead in Banaras', published by HarperCollins. The book explores the city of Banaras (also known as Varanasi) in India, particularly its relationship with death and the afterlife. 'Fire on the Ganga' is the first attempt to document the everyday realities of Dom in Banaras. It delves into the historical past of Banaras, while narrowing its lens on some of the spirited characters of the Dom community. Through its stories of struggle and survival, loss and ambition, betrayal and love, it tells the heartbreaking, sometimes exhilarating story of a community struggling to find a place beyond that given by ancient tradition. 6. India France 21st edition of bilateral naval exercise 'Varun' -

India has decided to open an embassy in Timor-Leste, signaling its commitment to strengthening ties with the ASEAN (Association of Southeast Asian Nations) region. 8. Salem Sago gets GI tag



Salem district in the state of Tamil Nadu has gained praise for its sago production, which is widely recognized as sago. Salem Sago, locally known as Jawwarisi, is obtained from wet starch powder extracted from tapioca roots. Indian tapioca roots have a starch content of about 30-35%. Sago production has been a cornerstone of Salem's economic development since 1967. Currently, more than 80% of sago production in India is produced in the Salem region, with a significant portion marketed through Sagoserve. The request for Geographical Indication (GI) tag for Salem Sago (Javavarisi) was filed by Salem Starch and Sago Manufacturers Service Industrial Co-operative

Society Limited, commonly known as SagoServe. GI tag for farmers in Salem area and Salem, Erode, This could provide a significant boost to business for over 400 sago and starch units in areas like Nammakal and Dharmapuri. There is a long tradition of sago production in these areas. Salem district uses about 35,000 hectares of land for tapioca cultivation, with an average yield of between 25–30 tonnes per hectare. Sago has a low calorific value (310 kcal/100 g) and ranges from 2 to 4.5 mm in size. Remarkably, one kilogram of tapioca sago can be produced from five kilograms of tapioca tubers. In which the average yield per hectare is between 25-30 tonnes.
