

1. African Union becomes permanent member of G20 under the chairmanship of India



The African Union became a permanent member of the G20, the group of countries with the world's largest economies, on 09 September 2023. Prime Minister Narendra Modi, while addressing the inaugural session of the two-day G20 summit, announced the inclusion of the 55-nation African Union as a new member. At present the great brainstorming of G-20 leaders is going on in India. The G-20 Summit 2023 has started in the capital Delhi. With this, the African Union (AU) has been included as a new member in this group. After the announcement of inclusion of African Union as a permanent member in G20, PM Modi hugged and congratulated African Union President Azali Assoumani. After PM Modi's announcement, India's Foreign Minister S Jaishankar had brought along African Union President Azali Assoumani. Shortly after the announcement, Azali Assoumani, President of the Union of Comoros and Chair of the African Union (AU), addressed the G20. Took seat as a permanent member. Prime Minister Modi had raised the issue of AU membership prominently in the G20. In June, Modi had written a letter to G20 leaders advocating full membership of the AU during the summit in New Delhi. The proposal was formally included in the draft communiqué for the summit during the third G20 Sherpa meeting held in Hampi, Karnataka in July.

2. Indian archer Prathamesh Javkar gets silver in World Cup final



India's archer Prathamesh Javkar missed the gold medal by a narrow margin and had to settle for a silver medal in the Archery-World-Cup-Final-2023" Archery World Cup Final 2023. World number 14 Javkar finished 10th in the gold medal match. He was facing a big challenge against the ranked Denmark's Mathias Fullerton. The game ended in a 148-148 draw after five sets. While both the archers scored 10 in the shoot-off, Fullerton was declared the winner. Javkar started the day with an impressive 149-141 win against world number five Italian Miguel Becerra in the quarter-finals, according to Olympics.com. The Indian then defeated world no. The number one seed shot a perfect 150 against Netherlands' Mike Schlosser to book his place in the final by defeating the second seeded archer by one point, Abhishek Verma, the first Indian to win silver in the Archery World Cup final in 2015 in men's compound He was an archer and missed out on a medal after losing the bronze medal match. Verma defeated Sawyer Sullivan in the quarter-final tie-breaker after the score was tied at 146. In the semi-finals, the Indians lost 150-147 to eventual gold medalist Fullerton. Verma produced her best performance of the day in the bronze medal match against American Schlosser, scoring 149 points in five sets. However, Schloesser emerged victorious after shooting a perfect 150. On the other hand, in the women's compound event, defending world champion Aditi Gopichand Swami lost against Dane Tanja Gelenthien in the quarterfinals.

3. Goa Governor launches the torch for the 37th National Games



Governor of Goa Shri. P.S. Sreedharan Pillai officially launched the torch (torch) to mark the beginning of the 37th National Games. The anthem featured the traditional Goan instrument, the Ghumat, and featured a collaboration between Goan singers and other talented artists. 4. The world's highest fighter airport will be built in Nyoma, Ladakh.



The Border Roads Organization (BRO) is set to achieve a remarkable feat with the construction of the world's highest combat airfield at Nyoma in Ladakh. Defense Minister Rajnath Singh is going to lay the foundation stone of this ambitious project on September 12, 2023 at Devak Bridge in Jammu. This effort reflects BRO's dedication to strengthening India's defense capabilities in areas of strategic importance. Nyoma is situated as a major village situated in the southern region of Ladakh, India. It hosts an Indian Air Force base within the Leh district. Nyoma is notably home to an Advanced Landing Ground (ALG), established in 1962. The altitude of Nyoma reaches an impressive 4,180 meters (13,710 ft) above sea level, making it one of the highest altitudes in the region. Highlighting the financial commitment of the Central Government, Lieutenant General Choudhary revealed that the budget of BRO used to be around Rs 3,000 crore in 2008. This increased to Rs 5,000-6,000 crore in 2017. In 2019, it increased to Rs 8,000 crore and increased thereafter. And last year, around Rs 12,340 crore was spent. 'Hello UPI' enables users to make payments through interactive interactions using their smartphones. It simplifies various payment tasks, including splitting restaurant bills, Including sending money to friends and settling utility bills. NPCI's 'Hello UPI' supports voice-enabled UPI payments in both Hindi and English. There are plans to expand language support to include other regional languages, ensuring inclusivity for a wider user base. NPCI collaborated with Bhashini Program at IIT Madras and Al4India to jointly develop a payment language model in Hindi and English. This collaboration promotes the advancement of indigenous technology and contributes to the success of these interactive payment initiatives.

Streamlining Bill Payments: BillPay Connect aims to streamline the bill payment process by enabling users to easily pay their bills using natural interactions with popular voice assistants like Alexa.

Accessibility for all users: This initiative is designed to cater to a wide range of users with different levels of technical proficiency. Whether individuals have access to a feature phone, smartphone, or merchant soundbox, digital bill payment has become accessible to all.

Instant Voice Confirmation: Users can easily retrieve and settle their bills through voice commands on smart home devices and receive instant voice confirmation. Additionally, this facility extends to bill payments made at physical collection centers through Payment Soundbox devices.

6. State Bank launches 'One Nation-One Card '



State Bank of India (SBI), the largest public sector bank, has launched 'Nation First Transit Card'. This card provides a lot of convenience to the customer. With this you can make easy digital ticketing payment for metro, bus and parking etc. through a single medium. On launching the card, SBI said that continuous efforts are being made to make banking and everyday life easier for customers. State Bank of India Chairman Dinesh Kumar Khara said, 'The Nation First Transit Card, powered by RuPay and National Common Mobility Card (NCMC) technology, "It is set to revolutionize the commuting experience and is aligned with the national vision of One Nation One Card." The card was launched at the Global Fintech Fest 2023. India's largest lender said it is also going to implement NCMC based ticketing solution in MMRC Metro Line 3 and Agra Metro, which will be available to the public very soon. State Bank of India is the largest lender in the country. The home loan portfolio of the bank has crossed ₹6.53 lakh crore. As of June 2023, the bank's deposit base is over ₹45.31 lakh crore, with a CASA ratio of 42.88 per cent and advances of over ₹33 lakh crore.

7. Bank of Baroda has started a new facility, you can withdraw money using UPI.



Bank of Baroda, for the first time in the country, has started the facility of withdrawing money from ATM without card for its customers. In the first phase, this system has been started in six thousand ATMs across the country. Customers can avail this facility using their UPI. The new UPI ATM has been launched by Hitachi Payment Services in collaboration with National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI). Many products have been launched by NPCI at the Global Fintech Fest 2023 to promote digital transactions. After the launch of this service, customers will no longer need to carry their ATM card with them. According to the statement issued by BOB, it is the first public sector bank in the country to launch UPI ATM operated by NCR Corporation in coordination with National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI). The bank said that customers of its and other banks can withdraw cash from Bank of Baroda UPI ATMs without using their debit cards through the UPI-enabled mobile app. According to the statement, UPI ATM enables QR-based seamless cash withdrawal through Interoperable Cardless Cash Withdrawal (ICCW) technology, which does not require a card to withdraw cash. A major advantage of UPI ATM facility is that customers can withdraw cash from various accounts linked to UPI.

8. RBI may launch digital rupee pilot for interbank transactions by October



The Reserve Bank of India can start the pilot project of Central Bank Digital Currency i.e. CBDC in Interbank Borrowing and Call Money Market in October. This information has been given by RBI Executive Director Ajay Kumar Chaudhary. Wholesale CBDC, also known as Digital Rupee-Wholesale (eW). It was launched on November 1, 2022. At present it is being used in the secondary market for transactions in government securities. State Bank of India, Bank of Baroda, Union Bank of India, HDFC Bank, ICICI Bank, Kotak Mahindra

Bank, Yes Bank, IDFC First Bank and HSBC have been selected by RBI for the wholesale pilot project. The pilot project of retail incarnation of CBDC by the Central Bank on December 1, Was started in 2022. CBDC is the digital incarnation of India's paper currency. It is recognized by RBI as paper currency. India's digital revolution has been showcased by RBI at the G20 Summit. These include Public Tech Platform (PTP), CBDC, UPI One World, RuPay on-the-go and Bharat Bill Payment System for frictionless credit.
