

1. In basketball, Germany won the World Cup for the first time by defeating Serbia.



Germany defeated Serbia 83-77 to win the 2023 FIBA World Cup of Basketball. Germany went ahead 8-0. Remained undefeated in the tournament and became the fifth consecutive World Cup champion. Tournament Most Valuable Player Dennis Schröder led Germany with 28 points, well above his average of 17.9 points per game, and added two rebounds and two assists. Serbia lost 129-92 to the US in the 2014 final but were eliminated in the quarter-finals in 2019. Earlier, Canada achieved its first podium finish in the World Cup by defeating USA 127-118 in overtime in a record-setting bronze medal match. The 19th edition of FIBA's flagship event, co-hosted by the Philippines, Indonesia and Japan, Started on a high level. The 2023 FIBA Basketball World Cup was the 19th tournament of the FIBA Basketball World Cup for men's national basketball teams. The tournament was the second to feature 32 teams and was hosted by multiple countries -Philippines, Japan and Indonesia – for the first time in its history from 25 August to 10 September 2023.

2. India, Britain in favor of early conclusion of free trade agreement



India and Britain expressed their commitment for the early conclusion of a Free Trade Agreement (FTA)

between the two countries. India and the United Kingdom have jointly announced the launch of the Infrastructure Financing Bridge during the 12th Economic and Financial Dialogue (EFD). This collaborative initiative reflects the continued commitment of both countries to work together to substantial infrastructure unlock investment opportunities in India. The statement highlights that the UK has significant expertise in finance and project management, making it a valuable partner for India in infrastructure development. Recognizing position as an investment powerhouse in technology, fintech and green transition, The cooperation aims to leverage India's vital role in driving global economic growth. The formal launch of UKIIFB under the joint leadership of NITI Aayog (a policy think tank in India) and the City of London is the centerpiece of this collaboration. UKIIFB's primary objective is to unlock infrastructure investment opportunities and utilize the City of London's expertise in structuring and phasing major infrastructure projects. This partnership seeks to secure long-term investments for critical infrastructure sectors in India. UKIIFB stakeholders are committed to building a diversified investment and financing system characterized by sustainability and manageable risks. This historic collaboration places a strong emphasis on sustainable infrastructure development, giving priority to environmentally friendly projects that align with the core principles of the Sustainable Development Goals.

### 3. Vijayawada Railway Station gets 'Green Railway Station' certificate from IGBC



Vijayawada Railway Station has been awarded the 'Green Railway Station' certification with the highest rating of Platinum by the Indian Green Building Council (IGBC) for its efforts in improving environmental

standards and providing eco-friendly services to passengers. . This is an upgrade to the station's ratings. This station was given gold rating in 2019 and platinum rating in 2023. The energy efficient and solid waste management measures taken by the station over the years have helped the station achieve a platinum rating. Some of these measures include use of star-rated electrical appliances, LED lights, installation of sewage treatment plants for recycling of waste water, This includes periodic testing to check smoke emissions etc. IGBC in collaboration with Environment Directorate of Indian Railways has developed Green Railway Station Rating System to adopt green concept and provide better passenger experience. The rating is based on six environmental categories defined by the IGBC. These are; Sustainable station facilities include health, hygiene and sanitation, energy efficiency, water efficiency, smart and green initiatives and innovation and development.

# 4. Britain commits two billion US dollars to 'Green Climate Fund'



Britain said it will provide US\$2 billion for a Green Climate Fund (GCF) to help the world tackle climate change. The British High Commission in India said that British Prime Minister Rishi Sunak has announced this financial contribution to help the vulnerable people of the world reduce and adapt to the effects of climate change. The Green Climate Fund (GCF), recognized as the largest fund of its kind in the world, was established within the framework of the United Nations climate change negotiations. Its primary objective is to facilitate the flow of financial resources needed to assist developing countries in their efforts to achieve various climate-related goals. These goals include reducing

carbon emissions, Including promoting clean energy sources and adapting to the consequences of a warming planet. The UK has made a broad commitment to international climate finance, pledging a total of £11.6 billion (equivalent to \$14.46 billion) for the period 2021 to 2026. Notably, Prime Minister Sunak's latest announcement represents a significant 12.7% increase in comparison. The UK's previous contribution to the GCF, for the period 2020 to 2023, underlines the country's commitment to addressing climate change at a global level.

5. Indore tops in Clean Air Survey 2023



Union Environment, Forest and Climate Change Minister Bhupendra Yadav announced the results of the Clean Air Survey 2023 in Bhopal, in which Madhya Pradesh's Indore has claimed the top position among cities with a population of more than one million. This survey covered 130 identified cities under the National Clean Air Programme. Agra, Uttar Pradesh secured the second position, followed by Thane, Maharashtra at the third position. The awards were categorized based on the city's population as per the 2011 census. In the three to ten lakh population category, Amravati, Maharashtra took the top position. Among cities with population less than three lakh, Himachal Pradesh's Parwanoo and Kala Amb were leading, while Odisha's Angul stood third. With changes in the rankings compared to last year, Cities were rated on various factors related to air quality. Swachh Air Survekshan is an initiative to assess air quality in Indian cities. This is important because it promotes clean air and tracks improvements. Indore excelled in controlling several air pollutants, reducing emissions and raising public awareness, earning it the top spot. #### 6. North Korea launches new 'strategic nuclear attack submarine '



North Korea made headlines by launching its first operational "strategic nuclear attack submarine," named submarine No. 841 and named for former North Korean Navy commander Hero Kim Kun Ok. The launch ceremony took place in the presence of North Korean leader Kim Jong Un, where he highlighted the importance of this new addition to their naval force. Analysts believe Submarine No. 841 is a modified version of the Soviet-era Romeo-class submarine, which North Korea acquired from China in the 1970s and later began producing domestically. Its design has 10 launch tube hatches, indicating that it is likely armed with ballistic missiles and cruise missiles. Nevertheless, its age, noise level, slow speed, and limited range raise concerns about the submarine's effectiveness in modern warfare. The designation of submarine No. 841 as a "strategic" submarine suggests that it cannot carry submarine-launched ballistic missiles (SLBMs) capable of reaching the US mainland. Instead, it is likely to have smaller, short-range SLBMs or submarine-launched cruise missiles (SLCMs) with the capability to attack regional targets such as South Korea and Japan. The submarine's extended rear part of the sail and installation of 10 vertical launch tubes, including both

large and small, indicate its capability to launch SLBMs and SLCMs.
