

 Haryana government appointed actress Mita Vashishtha as chairperson of Entertainment Policy Council



The Haryana government has appointed film actress Mita Vashishtha as the chairperson of the Governing Council to monitor the implementation of the Haryana Film and Entertainment Policy (HFEP). This post was vacant after the death of director and producer Satish Kaushik. He was appointed as the first Chairman by the Haryana Government. Mita Vashishtha has 43 years of experience in films, television serials and theater productions. She has served as visiting faculty in prestigious institutions like National School of Drama (NSD), National Institute of Fashion Technology (NIFT), National Institute of Design (NID), Whistling Woods International (WWI). She has also held the position of head of the acting department in the Film and Television Institute (FTII). According to Haryana Government spokesperson Meeta Vashishtha Information, Public Relations, The Administrative Secretary of the Language and Culture Department will also be the Co-Chairman of the Governing Council and the Director General of the Information, Public Relations, Language and Culture Department will also be the Member Secretary. 8. Punjab Health Minister Balbir Singh launches 'Mission Intensive Indradhanush' 5.0 in Mohali



Punjab Health Minister Balbir Singh launched "Mission Intensive Indradhanush" 5.0 from Dr. BR Ambedkar Medical College, Mohali. Health Secretary and Mission Director Abhinay Trikha and other officials were also present on this occasion. Earlier it was planned for August along with the rest of the country. But it got delayed due to the flood situation in the state. Mission Indradhanush provides vaccination against 12 vaccinepreventable diseases-VPDs-ie diphtheria, whooping cough, tetanus, polio, tuberculosis, hepatitis B, meningitis and pneumonia, Haemophilus influenzae. The mission aims to cover pregnant women who have received partial vaccination or who have not been vaccinated. Additionally, it attempts to reach children aged 0-5 years who have missed their vaccinations. During the mission, A total of 6156 vaccination sessions will be conducted across the state of Punjab. Vaccination teams will focus their efforts on reaching remote areas, especially brick kilns and places where migrant laborers live. Identification and vaccination of individuals in these areas will be the top priority.

Willmutt and his team created Dolly the sheep in 1996. Campbell, a teammate of Willamette, died in 2012. According to the AP report, the method by which Wilmut created Dolly the sheep was the first incident in the world of cloning in which a mature adult cell was prepared from a newly fertilized embryo.
