

2. RBI's financial inclusion index reached 60.1 in March



The overall financial inclusion index of the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) increased to 60.1 in March, 2023 showing an increase in all parameters. This index of RBI is based on compilation of data related to various aspects of financial inclusion. This index is prepared on the basis of a value range from zero to 100. RBI said in a statement that the financial inclusion index for the financial year ending March 2023 stood at 60.1 points while in March 2022 it stood at 56.4. During this period, growth has been recorded in all sub-indices. According to the statement, expansion of access and quality dimensions played an important role in improving the financial inclusion index. The Reserve Bank had introduced the concept of a composite index in August 2021 after consultation with the government and various regulators. It includes details related to banking, investment, insurance, postal service and pension sectors. The Financial Inclusion Index is based on three broad parameters. In this, the weightage of access is 35 percent, the weightage of utilization is 45 percent and the weightage of quality is 20 percent. The FI index provides a single numerical value on a scale from 0 to 100. In this scale, a score of 0 indicates complete financial exclusion, while a score of 100 indicates complete financial inclusion.

3. Rahul Naveen takes charge as Director of Enforcement Directorate



Rahul Naveen will be the executive director of the Enforcement Directorate. Rahul Naveen will hold the post till the appointment of the new director of ED. 4. BAE Systems, L&T join hands to bring all-terrain vehicle in India



BAE Systems Inc. and Larsen & Toubro Ltd. (L&T) have partnered to bring the world-leading Articulated All-Terrain Vehicle (AATV), BVS10, to the Indian market, the company announced through an exchange filing. The two companies have signed an agreement to offer the BvS10 for the Indian Armed Forces programme. Under the agreement, L&T is the lead bidder for the Indian market, in collaboration with BAE Systems Haglunds, the Swedish manufacturer of the highly successful BvS10 family of vehicles. BAE Systems and L&T have upgraded the BVS10 to meet the specific requirements of the Indian Armed Forces. This new version will be known as "BVS10-Sindhu". The AATV program aims to equip L&T's Armored System Complex with Integrated Logistic Support (ILS), Vehicle has to be delivered from Hazira. "Our ByS10 all-terrain vehicle will demonstrate critical capabilities required by the Indian Army when it participates in trials later this month. Unmatched mobility, flexibility and the ability to operate in extreme climatic conditions are at the core of the BvS10 design," said Tommy Gustafsson-Rask, Managing Director of BAE Systems Hägglunds. "Our teaming with Larsen & Toubro gives us the opportunity to expand into the Indo-Pacific market."

5. NABARD and UNDP India join hands for data-driven agricultural innovation





United Nations Development Program (UNDP) and National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development (NABARD) signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) to co-create data-driven innovations in agriculture and food systems to support smallholder farmers Are. Under this MoU both organizations will work to improve the lives and livelihoods of smallholder farmers by sharing open-source data to support product development, technology transfer and formulation of agricultural policies. The MoU was signed by NABARD Chief General Manager Sanjeev Rohilla and UNDP Deputy Resident Representative Isabel San. Under the MoU, UNDP will leverage its expertise in open innovations, data collaboration, data science approaches and global information to support NABARD's agenda of data-driven decision making in agricultural investments. This includes enhancing and disseminating collaborative digital public goods such as DICRA (Data in Climate Resilient Agriculture). DICRA is a collaborative digital public good that provides open access to key geospatial datasets related to climate resilient agriculture. DICRA has been created by UNDP and partner organizations to inform public investment in agriculture. It already provides climate resilience information for India's 50 million hectares of agricultural land. Under this partnership, NABARD will maintain and maintain the DICRA platform with technical support from UNDP to enhance its use. It will also use its key geospatial datasets for policy making, research and development activities. This five-year technical collaboration is envisioned to promote collective climate action, provide a new platform to enhance economic empowerment in rural India, and introduce new product offerings.

6. Aadhaar, driving license, birth certificate will be single document for jobs from next month



The Union Home Ministry has unveiled notable amendments in the use of birth certificates for essential services, which will come into effect from October 1, 2023. These changes, driven by the Registration of Births and Deaths (Amendment) Act, 2023, are designed to enhance the efficiency and transparency of public service delivery. The Act establishes a national registry of births and deaths under the supervision of the Registrar General of India. State level Chief Registrars and Registrars will also maintain similar databases. Previously, specific individuals, such as medical officers, were responsible for reporting births and deaths. Now, the list of correspondents has expanded. This includes adoptive parents for non-institutional adoption, biological parents for birth through surrogacy, and single parents or unmarried mothers for the birth of their child. Act authorized authorities with the approval of the Central Government, Allows sharing of national databases such as population registers and electoral rolls. Similarly, state databases can be shared with state-sanctioned authorities. If anyone disagrees with the action or order of the Registrar or District Registrar, they can appeal to the concerned District Registrar or Chief Registrar within 30 days of receiving the order. A decision on the appeal must be made within 90 days.

7. Brigadier Sanjay Kumar Mishra, a famous ophthalmologist in Pune, was named Dr. A.M. honored with Gokhale Award



Renowned Ophthalmologist Brigadier Sanjay Kumar Mishra of Indian Army Research and Referral Hospital was awarded the prestigious "Dr. A.M. Gokhale Award" in Pune. Dr. A.M. Gokhale was a renowned teacher of ophthalmology and his students progressed to become luminaries of ophthalmology in the country. Brigadier Mishra is one of the highest decorated officers of the Indian Armed Forces Medical Services. Sanjay Kumar Mishra has performed surgery on two serving Presidents of India. Brigadier Sanjay Kumar Mishra is a resident of Mau, Uttar Pradesh and has completed his tuition from Prayagraj. He has been awarded the Bar to Sena Medal (Distinguished) by the President of India just before 26 January 2021. Earlier he was awarded the Sena Medal and Bar to Vishisht Seva Medal (VSM). Establishing his residency at Command Hospital, Lucknow, he established the State of the Art Retina Center in 2018 keeping in mind the patients from different states. Brigadier Mishra is one of the highest decorated officers of the Indian Armed Forces Medical Services Are. Apart from this, it is also claimed about the military surgeon that he is the only ophthalmologist who has performed surgeries on two Presidents of India including Ramnath Kovind while in service. A release issued by Rashtrapati Bhavan said that the Medical Dialogues team had earlier informed that the cataract operation of the right eye of President Draupadi Murmu has been done at the Army Hospital (Referral and Research).

8. India gets its first Airbus C295 aircraft



The Indian Air Force has received its first C-295 transport aircraft from the European company Airbus Defense and Space. Now this aircraft is reaching India on 15th September. The first C 295 transport aircraft has been delivered to the Indian Air Force in Spain. For this, Indian Air Force Air Chief Marshal VR Chaudhary has reached Spain. After taking delivery of the aircraft, the Air Force Chief also flew in the new aircraft. These aircraft can do short take-off and landing. According to experts, this aircraft can take-off at a distance of only 320 meters. It requires only 670 meters length for landing. In such a situation, this aircraft can take part in Air Force operations in hilly areas like Ladakh, Kashmir, Assam and Sikkim near the India-China border. The aircraft can carry a weight of 5 to 10 tonnes. The plane carried with it at one time 71 soldiers, 44 paratroopers, Can carry 24 stretchers or 5 cargo pallets. Along with this, this transport aircraft can fly for 11 hours at a speed of 480 kilometers per hour. During the meeting, matters related to strengthening bilateral relations between the two countries were discussed. The deal signed with Airbus Defense and Space is for 56 aircraft. Of these, 16 aircraft are being manufactured in Spain while the remaining 40 aircraft will be manufactured by Tata Advanced Systems Company in Vadodara, Gujarat. This aircraft is built at the Seville plant in Spain. It will be inducted into the Air Force on September 25 at Hindon Airbase.
