



1. Elavenil Valarivan won gold medal in Rio Shooting World Cup



Olympian Elavenil Valarivan won her second gold medal in the women's 10m air rifle event at the International Shooting Sport Federation (ISSF) World Cup Rifle/Pistol competition in Rio de Janeiro. Elavenil played to perfection in the strong eight-woman final field, never scoring below 10.1 in the entire 24 shots. She finished with a score of 252.2, ahead of France's 20-year-old sensation Ossien Muller, who won the silver medal with 251.9. China's Zhang Jiale got the bronze medal. Elavenil had qualified for the finals in eighth and last place with a score of 630.5. Muller topped with 633.7. Two Chinese shooters Zhang Jiale and Zhang Yu (Olympians) and reigning European champion Jeanette Hague Duestad of Norway were also among the finalists. In the men's 10m air rifle event, India's lone contender Sandeep Singh shot 628.2 in qualification and finished 14th. Elavenil, along with Sandeep, had finished fifth in the 10m air rifle mixed team event with a combined score of 629.1. The fourth and final medal round spot went to Israel, which was 0.5 points ahead of the Indian pair in the 42-team field. Elavenil shot 314.8 while Sandeep shot 314.3, helping the Indians miss out on a bronze medal. Israel ultimately won the bronze medal, while Germany won the gold medal and the silver went to Hungary. A 16-member Indian team was participating in seven Olympic events in the Rio World Cup. Italy top the medal tally with two golds while India is joint third with Armenia.

4. SIDBI to raise Rs 10,000 crore from rights issue in the next financial year



Small Industries Development Bank of India (SIDBI) is planning to raise Rs 10,000 crore from a rights issue in the next financial year to expand its equity capital. A top official of SIDBI gave this information. The central government holds 20.8 percent stake in SIDBI, while State Bank of India (SBI) holds 15.65 percent and Life Insurance Corporation (LIC) holds 13.33 percent. The remaining stake is held by other public financial institutions and banks. SIDBI's growth outlook is primarily driven by the growing demand for direct financing, a segment that has grown significantly over the last two years, now accounting for 14% of its loan portfolio, up from only 7% earlier. SIDBI Chairman and Managing Director (MD) Sivasubramaniam Raman said the proposed rights issue will come in two tranches of Rs 5.000 crore each in the next financial year. It aims to expand the capital base by Rs 10,000 crore and support the growing balance sheet, which is expected to grow by one-fourth of the current level. SIDBI Chairman and Managing Director, Sivasubramaniam Raman has

revealed that the rights issue will be executed in two tranches of Rs 5,000 crore each during the next financial year. This strategy will increase the capital base of the institution to a total of Rs 10,000 crore, providing significant support to its growing balance sheet, which is projected to expand to a quarter of its current size. While SIDBI's capital adequacy ratio (CAR) saw a decline from 24.28% in FY2012 to 19.29% in FY2013 and 15.63% in the June 2023 quarter, the decline was attributed to lack of capital in expanding the bank's portfolio. Attributed to efficient use.

5. Fashion designer Rahul Mishra honored with France's Chevalier dans l'Ordre des Arts et des Lettres award
