

1. Mike Johnson was elected the new Speaker of the US House of Representatives



Republican Party MP from Louisiana Mike Johnson has been elected Speaker of the House of Representatives, ending three weeks of uncertainty in American politics. The post of Speaker of the House of Representatives is one of the most powerful political positions in the country and is considered third in the line of succession after the President of the United States. For the first time in American history, on Wednesday, three weeks after Kevin McCarthy was removed from the post of Speaker, Johnson was elected in Congress by 220 votes against 209 in a very tough contest. In the 435-member House, the Republican Party has a slight majority with 221 seats against the Democratic Party's 212 seats. Johnson (51), the 56th Speaker of the House of Representatives, is a lawyer by profession and has been a four-time MP from Louisiana's 4th Congressional District. In his first address to Congress, Johnson said his first legislative agenda would be to introduce a resolution in support of Israel, a country that suffered a terrorist attack by Hamas earlier this month. Former President Donald Trump supported Mike Johnson's candidacy for the post of Speaker of the House. Trump expressed confidence that Johnson would be a great speaker. Speaker Johnson stressed the urgency of addressing critical issues. He pledged to provide strength, perseverance, and hope to the American people and indicated an aggressive legislative program. President Joe Biden congratulated Speaker Johnson and expressed his desire to work together. Biden highlighted the need for mutual efforts to find common ground on important issues despite disagreements.

2. Richard Roundtree, the first black action hero, dies at 81



Actor Richard Roundtree, famous as 'Black Action Hero', died at the age of 81. The cause of his death is said to be pancreatic cancer. This information has come to light from Hollywood publication Deadline. He was known for the film 'Shaft' released in 1971. With this movie he became an overnight star at a young age. It was the first blaxploitation film in American history. He played the role of a private detective in this film. Along with the screenplay of the film, Richard's powerpack performance won the hearts of people. After the success of this movie, some sequels and television spinoffs were made. Richard's manager Patrick McMinnnon said that his work and career were a turning point for the African and American film industries. His contribution to the film industry cannot be forgotten. Richard Roundtrick was called America's first black action hero. After his success, the way into the glamor world opened for other black artists too. After the super success of 'Shaft', he worked in many films like 'Shaft in Africa', 'Steel', 'Moving On', 'Man Friday'. Roundtree attended New Rochelle High School, where he played on an undefeated football team. He graduated in 1961 and began attending Southern Illinois University on a football scholarship. However, her life took a different turn when she spent the summer as a model at the Ebony Fashion Fair, sponsored by a leading Black news and culture magazine. This experience took him to New York, where he began a successful theater career by joining the Negro Ensemble Company. In 2011, he garnered an African-American Film Critics Association award, while in 1994, he claimed an MTV Movie + TV Award for his role in "Shaft." Additionally, she earned a nomination for the Golden Globe Awards in 1972 and was recognized at the Soap Opera Digest Awards, among other accolades.

3. India and Malaysia launched bilateral exercise " Abhyas Harimau Shakti 2023 ".

5. Kerala government to set up graphene production facility worth Rs 237 crore



Kerala Chief Minister Pinarayi Vijayan announced the setting up of a graphene production facility with an estimated investment of Rs 237 crore which will function on a public-private partnership model. Chief Minister Pinarayi Vijayan took the decision to set up this innovative graphene production facility in a cabinet meeting recently. The proposal aims to secure loans from the Kerala Infrastructure Investment Fund Board (KIIFB) and seek private partners through global expressions of interest. 6. External Affairs Minister Jaishankar left on a twoday visit to Kyrgyzstan



Indian External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar recently visited Kyrgyzstan for a two-day visit. During his visit, he discussed various areas of cooperation with Kyrgyz President Sadyr Zhaparov. The visit also includes Jaishankar's participation in the Shanghai Cooperation Organization (SCO) meeting. Jaishankar held discussions with President Sadyr Zhaparov to explore opportunities to enhance cooperation in banking, defense and energy sectors. They discussed wide-ranging sectors like banking, energy, health, pharmaceuticals, defence, agriculture and investments. Jaishankar will attend the SCO Council of Heads of Government (CHG) meeting hosted by Kyrgyzstan. Prominent personalities like Russian Foreign Minister Sergei Lavrov and Chinese Foreign Minister Wang Yi will attend this meeting. The Ministry of External Affairs (MEA) confirmed Jaishankar's visit and his role in leading the Indian delegation to the SCO meeting. The External Affairs Ministry said Jaishankar will also meet his counterparts from other SCO member states and call on the top leadership of Kyrgyzstan. The visit reflects India's commitment to maintaining and strengthening diplomatic relations within the SCO framework. Its objective is to promote regional cooperation and meaningful dialogue among member countries. The SCO plays an important role in addressing regional and global challenges, encouraging economic cooperation

and facilitating discussion on political and security matters among its member states.

7. Election Commission to appoint actor Rajkumar Rao as its 'national icon '



This time the Election Commission of India has decided to make actor Rajkumar Rao its national icon. The Commission will appoint Rajkumar Rao as icon. National icons make people aware about voting. Their effort is to increase the voting percentage. Although actor Rajkumar Rao has worked in many films and many of his films have been hits, but 'Newton' is a film which gave him a different identity. 8. FPI sold Indian shares worth Rs 7702 crore in the biggest one - day selloff of the year



Foreign institutional investors (FIIs) continued their selling in the Indian stock market, while domestic institutional investors (DIIs) emerged as net buyers. The trend occurred on the day of monthly futures and options (F&O) expiry, with domestic markets closing lower for the sixth consecutive day. According to National Stock Exchange (NSE) data, FIIs collectively bought Indian equities worth ₹10,239.05 crore, but they also sold ₹17,941.58 crore. This resulted in a net outflow of ₹7,702.53 crore. Fils are selling Indian equities due to factors like rising US bond yields and strengthening dollar index, which has negatively impacted market sentiment. In contrast, DIIs were net buyers on the day, investing ₹13,600.71 crore in Indian stocks and selling ₹7,042.26 crore. This resulted in a net inflow of ₹6,558.45 crore. Weak global cues played a key role in the market performance. Investors turned away from local equities, triggering selling, as the benchmark Nifty closed below 19,000 points. Frontline banking, automobile and IT stocks experienced selling as investors were concerned about various factors including the ongoing conflict in West Asia, economic uncertainty and concerns about possible interest rate hikes. Commenting on the situation, Shrikant Chauhan, Head of Equity Research (Retail), Kotak Securities, said investors continued to be bearish for the sixth consecutive session. Factors contributing to this sentiment include weak global cues, concerns about the West Asia conflict, Concerns include economic uncertainty and rising interest rates.
