1. Virat Kohli becomes player of the tournament in World Cup 2023



Indian star batsman Virat Kohli has been awarded the title of 'Player of the Tournament' in the ICC World Cup 2023 for his brilliant performance. Kohli has the highest score of 765 runs in the tournament, including three centuries. In the World Cup final played at the Narendra Modi Stadium, Australia ended India's unbeaten streak in the tournament and won the title by 6 wickets. This is the sixth time that Australia has won this title. The International Cricket Council (ICC) has named Virat Kohli as the ICC Men's ODI World Cup 2023 Player of the Tournament, as the Indian batsman has scored the most runs (765) by any player in the history of the tournament. In the final match against the victorious Australian team at the Narendra Modi Stadium in Ahmedabad, Kohli scored 54 runs in 63 balls in challenging conditions. However, he had an excellent tournament overall, with three centuries and six halfcenturies at an average of 101.57 and a strike rate of 90.69. Virat Kohli won the Player of the Tournament award. Kohli's performance with the bat in the World Cup 2023 was excellent. King Kohli batted brilliantly and scored 765 runs in 11 matches. Virat played a century against New Zealand in the semi-final match, while in the final match also, Virat scored a half-century.

2. India Vs Australia ICC World Cup Final 2023: Australia becomes World Cup champion, wins the title for the sixth time



India and Australia faced each other again in the ICC World Cup final after 2003, in which the Kangaroos once again won. Australia won the cup for the sixth time by defeating India by 6 wickets. India lived the ICC Cricket World Cup 2023 as a celebration. With a brilliant start to the World Cup, India rode its victory chariot rapidly throughout the tournament. India played 11 matches during this period, in which India registered a resounding victory in 10 matches. However, the final match against Australia healed the wounds of 2003. After winning the toss in the final match, Australia invited India to bat first. The Indian team led by captain Rohit Sharma got a good start, but India got the first blow in the form of Shubman Gill (4) on 30 runs. After some time, Rohit Sharma (47) fell victim to Glenn Maxwell's ball at the score of 76 runs. Meanwhile, Shreyas Iyer (4) also became the victim of Pat Cummins on the second ball of the 11th over. The effect of 3 wickets in the first 11 overs was clearly visible on the Indian batting. After this, the pace of runs started slowing down and the Indian team struggled and barely reached the score of 240 runs, losing all 10 wickets, in which KL Rahul (66) and Virat Kohli (54) made the biggest contribution. Australia's start to chase the target of 241 runs was also not special. Three Australian players were out in the first 10 overs. After this, openers Travis Head and Marnus Labuschagne took charge of Australia's innings and made a partnership of 192 runs. Travis Head (137) was out on the fifth ball of the 43rd over, but by then the game had slipped out of India's hands. Maxwell completed the formalities by scoring 2 runs and Australia won the World Cup for the 6th time.

3. RBI imposed a fine of Rs 90.92 lakh on Axis Bank

After this, RBI imposed a fine of Rs 90.92 lakh on the bank for not following the 2016 guidelines related to KYC. Along with sharing the information about imposing penalty on Axis Bank, RBI has also made it clear that this action has been taken on the basis of deficiencies in regulatory compliance. The purpose of this action of the Central Bank is not at all to affect the validity of any transactions or agreements made by the bank with its customers (Axis Bank Customers).

Byatt's literary journey began in 1964 with the publication of her first novel, "Shadow of a Sun". The work is based on the story of a young girl living under the shadow of an influential father. Despite further work thereafter, it was not until 1983 that Byatt made the momentous decision to leave teaching and devote himself fully to writing. In 1990, A. S. Byatt scored a breakthrough with "Position: A Romance," a novel that quickly became a bestseller and won the prestigious Booker Prize for fiction that same year. The story of an academic treasure hunt, pitting an American biographer against a beleaguered English scholar, marks a departure from Byatt's prior style, adopting a more commercially oriented approach. Byatt's contributions to literature led to numerous awards and titles, including CBE (Commander of the Order of the British Empire) and DBE (Dame of the British Empire). Her literary prowess extended to the silver screen with the adaptation of "Positions" into a feature film starring Gwyneth Paltrow. Another of his works, "Angels and Insects" also took the path of cinematic adaptation.
