



1. Abdullahi Mayer receives the UNHCR Nansen Refugee Award



Somali refugee Abdullahi Maarey has been named the 2023 UNHCR Nansen Refugee Prize Global Laureate for his work advocating the right to education for displaced children. Mair, who grew up in the Dadaab refugee camps in Kenya, has delivered more than 100,000 books into the hands of displaced children and youth in the country. He will be presented with the award at a ceremony in Geneva, Switzerland on December 13, 2023. In addition to the global award winner, four regional winners have also been nominated for the 2023 UNHCR Nansen Refugee Prize: The UNHCR Nansen Refugee Prize was established in 1954 in honor of the legacy of Fridtjof Nansen, Norwegian scientist, polar explorer, diplomat and first High Commissioner for Refugees of the League of Nations. Was done to honor. This award is presented annually to an individual or organization for outstanding service to refugees. The UNHCR Nansen Refugee Award consists of a commemorative medal and a monetary award of US\$100,000. Global award winners are expected to reinvest the prize into the humanitarian initiatives for which they are being recognized. Several regional winners will also receive a small monetary award to further their humanitarian work. The United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR) is a United Nations agency mandated to protect and assist refugees worldwide. UNHCR was established in 1950 and is headquartered in Geneva, Switzerland.

2. Center approves recovery plan of Rs 1658 crore for Joshimath



The Central Government approved Rs 1658 crore Recovery and Reconstruction (R&R) scheme for the landslide affected town of Joshimath. The scheme, implemented over three years, aims to address the crisis caused by city conditions, population pressure and construction of multi-storey buildings. The scheme includes central assistance of Rs 1080 crore from the National Disaster Response Fund and a contribution of Rs 126.4 crore from the SDRF of the state government. Additionally, the state budget will provide an amount of Rs 451.8 crore, including the cost of land acquisition, for rehabilitation. This includes the estimated cost of land acquisition for rehabilitation at Rs 92 crore. The Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) aims to implement a recovery plan for Joshimath over three years employing Build-Back-Better (BBB) principles, sustainability initiatives and other practices. The Home Ministry has nominated technical agencies under the guidance of the National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA) to assist the State Government in preparing and implementing the recovery plan. Significant land subsidence was felt in Joshimath and land subsidence occurred by 5.4 cm in a period of 12 days from December 27, 2022 to January 8, 2023. More than 700 houses developed cracks, forcing the Chamoli district administration to declare Joshimath as a landsubsidence zone. This led to families being shifted from affecting damaged residences. various infrastructure such as roads, hotels, homestays and hospitals.

4. National program to launch Anganwadi protocol for children with disabilities



The Ministry of Women and Child Development is preparing an important national program to launch Anganwadi protocol for children with disabilities. This initiative is an important component of Mission Saksham Anganwadi and Poshan Bhi Padhai Bhi program under Poshan 2.0. This program will be presided over by Union Minister Smriti Zubin Irani at Vigyan Bhawan in New Delhi. The highlight of the program will be a panel discussion focusing on strategies for early detection, screening and inclusion in Anganwadi centres. The panel will include senior officials from MoHFW, DEPwD and state WCD secretaries as well as experts from organizations like NIMHANS. Participation of CDPOs, women supervisors, Anganwadi workers and Asha workers from across the country is expected. In particular, experienced Anganwadi workers involved in the care of children with disabilities will share their insights and best practices. The primary goal of the event is to highlight the importance and feasibility of enhancing the well-being of children through early intervention and specialized support. Emphasis will be placed on infants and young risk or with children at disabilities developmental delays. The event aims to advocate the vital role of the Anganwadi eco-system in reaching more than eight crore children from birth to six years of age every day, terming it as a critical access point to secure the future of the country's children. Have to install. An important aspect of the initiative is to educate and support families and communities to increase the participation of children with disabilities in family and community life. Recognizing the importance of the Anganwadi system, the event will explore ways to improve the capacity of the ecosystem to build a strong foundation for the country's children.

5. Rituraj Gaikwad became the fastest Indian to score 4000 runs in T20 cricket.



Rituraj Gaikwad registered a big record in his name when he scored 7 runs in the Raipur T20 match between India and Australia. He has now become the fastest Indian batsman to score 4000 T20 runs. He has touched this figure in just 116 innings. Earlier this record was in the name of KL Rahul. KL had completed 4000 runs in T20 cricket in 117 innings. Out of these 116 innings, Rituraj has played 100 innings in IPL and other domestic tournament matches, while 16 of his innings have come in international cricket. He has scored a total of 5 centuries in the T20 matches played so far. Ruturaj's batting average in T20 cricket is 38+ and strike rate is 139+. West Indies' legendary batsman Chris Gayle is at the top among the fastest scorers of 4000 runs in T20 cricket. This player, known as Universe Boss, had scored 4000 runs in 107 innings of 109 matches. He made this record in the year 2012. Let us tell you that the first batsman to complete four thousand runs in T20 cricket is also there. Ruturaj Gaikwad made his international debut in July 2021. His career started with T20 matches. This match was played against host Sri Lanka in Colombo. In his short international career of two and a half years, Gaikwad got a chance to play only 18 T20 matches. Till now he has 450+ T20 International runs in his name. Gaikwad's batting average in T20 International has been 38+ and strike rate has been 144+. Gaikwad has also debuted in ODI. He has played 4 ODI matches and scored 106 runs.
