



1. Launch of 'Green Rising' initiative to empower youth in environmental initiatives



UNICEF's Generation Unlimited with India's Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change launches 'Green Rising' to engage youth in impactful grassroots environmental action. On December 8, at COP-28, UNICEF's Generation Unlimited, in collaboration with India's Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, unveiled the "Green Rising" initiative. This ground-breaking initiative through India's Yuva Abhiyaan, taking inspiration from the Mission Life movement, places special emphasis on engaging youth in impactful environmental action at the grassroots level. The recipients are selected through a meticulous process under the supervision of a committee composed of eminent personalities from the Indian film industry.

3. Google introduces AI model 'Gemini'



Google took its next leap into artificial intelligence with the launch of Project Gemini, an Al model trained to behave human-like, which is likely to stoke debate about the potential promise and dangers of the technology. The rollout will unfold in phases, including Gemini's "Nano" and "Pro" Less sophisticated versions called Bard will immediately be included in Google's Alpowered chatbot and its Pixel 8 Pro smartphone. With the help of Gemini, Google promises that Bard will become more intuitive and better at tasks that involve planning. According to Google, on the Pixel 8 Pro, Gemini will be able to instantly summarize recordings made on the device and provide automatic replies on messaging services starting with WhatsApp. Gemini's biggest advancements won't come until early 2024 when its Ultra model will be used as "Bard Advanced" What will be launched is a juiced-up version of the chatbot that will initially be offered only to a test audience. The AI, at first, will only work in English around the world, although Google executives assured reporters during a briefing that the technology would have no problem eventually diversifying into other languages. Based on a demonstration of Gemini to a group of journalists, Google's "Bard Advanced" Unprecedented AI could be capable of multitasking by simultaneously recognizing and understanding presentations consisting of text, photos, and video. Gemini will also eventually be incorporated into Google's flagship search engine, although the timing of that change has not yet been made clear.

4. Tata Motors opens its fourth scrapping plant in Punjab

5. Wax statue of Baba Ambedkar installed in Jaipur Wax Museum

6. ZPM leader Lalduhoma becomes the new Chief Minister of Mizoram, takes oath of office and secrecy



Zoram People's Movement leader Lalduhoma took oath as the Chief Minister of Mizoram. Lalduhoma took oath as CM during a ceremony held at the Raj Bhavan complex in Aizawl. Along with this, Zoram People's Movement (ZPM) leader Vanlalhalana, C. Lalsavivunga took oath as cabinet minister. Officials said that some other ZPM leaders will also take oath as ministers today. He told that Governor Hari Babu will administer the oath of office and secrecy to Kambhampati Lalduhoma and other ministers. The swearing-in ceremony was held in the Raj Bhavan complex in Aizawl. During this time, Lalduhoma was the CM and Vanlalhalana, C. Lalsavivunga took oath as cabinet minister. Mizoram has a 40-member assembly and the state can have 12 ministers including the Chief Minister. ZPM won 27 out of 40 seats in the state assembly elections. ZPM legislature party made Lalduhoma its leader and K. Sapdanga was chosen as the deputy leader. ZPM media cell general secretary Eddy Josangliyana said the party's advisory body Val Upa Council met Lalduhoma on Wednesday to decide the composition of the Council of Ministers. Mizoram, which has a 40-member assembly, can have 12 ministers including the Chief Minister. ZPM was registered as a political party in 2019. ZPM ousted the Mizo National Front (MNF) led by outgoing Chief Minister Zoramthanga from power. MNF, which won 26 seats in the 2018 elections in the state, won only 10 seats.

7. Arjun Munda got the responsibility of Agriculture Ministry in place of Narendra Singh Tomar.



President Draupadi Murmu accepted the resignations of Union Agriculture Ministers Narendra Singh Tomar, Prahlad Singh Patel and Renuka Singh Saruta. Now Union Minister Arjun Munda has been given additional charge of Agriculture Ministry in place of Narendra Singh Tomar. Minister of State Shobha Karandlaje was given additional charge of Minister of State in the Ministry of Food Processing Industries. Minister of State Rajiv Chandrashekhar was given the additional charge of Minister of State in the Ministry of Jal Shakti. Apart from this, Minister of State Bharati Praveen Pawar has been given additional charge as Minister of State in the Ministry of Tribal Affairs. Arjun Munda already has the Minister of Tribal Affairs while Shobha Karandlaje is the Minister of State for Agriculture and Farmers Welfare. Besides, Rajeev Chandrashekhar is also the Minister of State in the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology. Apart from this, Bharti Praveen is already holding the post of Minister of State in the Union Health and Family Welfare Department. After the resignation of Narendra Singh Tomar and Prahlad Singh Patel from the post of ministers, it is believed that both the leaders are in the race to become the CM of Madhya Pradesh. This is also because there is discussion in the political circles that BJP wants to give a chance to a new face. Although the party has not said anything regarding this. Saruta, Lok Sabha MP from Chhattisgarh, had recently contested the state assembly elections and won from Bharatpur-Sonhat seat. Let us tell you that BJP has achieved a big victory in both the states.

8. Nirmala Sitharaman and three other Indians included in "World's 100 Most Powerful Women"



In the latest release of Forbes' annual list of "The World's Most Powerful Women", four notable Indian celebrities have made it. Union Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman, HCL Corporation Chairperson Roshni Nadar Malhotra, Steel Authority of India Chairperson Soma Mandal and Biocon Executive Chairperson Kiran Mazumdar-Shaw have earned a place in this prestigious list. Nirmala Sitharaman, who served as India's first full-time female Finance Minister, achieved her best ranking at number 32, her fifth consecutive appearance on the list. Forbes highlighted his groundbreaking role and emphasized his prior experiences at the UK-based Association of Agricultural Engineers and the BBC World Service before entering politics. Roshni Nadar Malhotra, ranked 60, who took over as chairperson of HCL in July 2020, is an MBA from Kellogg School of Management. According to his official website, apart from his corporate success, his passion for wildlife and conservation is notable. She is married to Shikhar Malhotra and has two sons. Steel Authority of India Chairperson Soma Mandal is at 70th position. She created history as the first woman to lead SAIL in January 2021. A graduate in electrical engineering, Mondal's leadership is credited with propelling the state-run company to record financial growth, tripling profits to Rs 120 billion in his inaugural year. Kiran Mazumdar-Shaw, founder of biopharmaceutical firm Biocon in 1978, is ranked 76th. She was also among the richest people in India, according to a Forbes profile, after successfully leading Biocon into the lucrative US market. The top positions on the list are dominated by politicians, with European Commission President Ursula von der Leyen taking the No. 1 spot. He is followed by European Central Bank President Christine Lagarde, US Vice President Kamala Harris and Italian Prime Minister Giorgia Meloni.
