

1. Tiriyani block gets top position in NITI Aayog's first delta ranking



Tariyani block of Kumuram Bheem Asifabad district of Telangana has topped NITI Aayog's inaugural Delta Rankings, which was revealed at a virtual event organized by NITI Aayog. In a significant achievement for the Aspirational Block Program (ABP), Tiriyani block in Kumaram Bheem Asifabad district of Telangana has topped the first Delta ranking announced by NITI Aayog. The rankings, revealed during a virtual event at NITI Aayog, reflected the excellent performance and progress achieved by blocks across the country in the month of June 2023. The ranking was determined based on the performance of the blocks during the month and the progress achieved in key performance indicators (KPIs). This strategic approach is in line with the spirit of competitive and cooperative federalism, making it the first time that the ranking of the blocks has been calculated as part of the Aspirational Block Programme. Apart from ABP, the event also announced the Achievers of Development Program (ADP) rankings for October 2023. In this initiative, Raigarh of Odisha and Jamui of Bihar secured first and second position respectively. The top performing blocks and districts in thematic and overall categories were honoured, emphasizing the dual focus on both blocks and districts. A unique initiative was unveiled during the event, where top rankers from ABP and ADP will be displayed on the Wall of Fame at NITI Aayog. The Wall of Fame serves as a testament to the efforts and projects undertaken by the aspirational blocks and districts to improve their indicators and achieve remarkable progress. 2. The first AI programming language: Lisp (List Processing)



In the late 1950s, John McCarthy, an influential computer scientist, and his colleagues introduced the first Al programming language called Lisp (List Processing). Artificial Intelligence (AI) has changed the way we interact with technology, but its journey began with the development of the first AI programming language. The ability to handle symbolic

logic and adaptability made Lisp a powerful tool for building intelligent systems.

3. 'Best person' award given to Prashant Agarwal of Udaipur. National Award, honored by the President



On World Disability Day, at the felicitation ceremony organized by the Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities, Union Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment at Vigyan Bhawan, New Chief Guest President Draupadi Murmu presented the National Award to Prashant Agarwal, President of Narayan Seva Sansthan. This award was given to Agarwal in the 'Best Individual' category for his excellent work in the field of empowerment of disabled people. Prashant Aggarwal has been a pioneer in the distribution of residential schools, vocational rehabilitation centers and assistive devices to bring the disabled into the mainstream of society. The President honored him by presenting him a prize and certificate. In the auditorium when the President was felicitating him, the President honored Dr. Apte Subhash for the Best Rehabilitation Professional, Amazon India for the Best Employer for Disabled and Directorate of Social Justice and Disability Empowerment Madhya Pradesh for the implementation of Sugamya Bharat Abhiyan in various categories. 4. Appointment of Rajiv Anand as Chairman of Max Life Insurance



The Board of Max Life Insurance approved the appointment of Rajeev Anand as the new Chairman, marking a significant moment in the leadership of the company. In a recent development, Max Life Insurance, a major player in the insurance sector and a subsidiary of Max Financial Services, saw a significant leadership change. Outgoing chairman Analjit Singh resigned from the chairmanship and membership of the board of directors. In response, the Board approved the appointment of Rajeev Anand as the new Chairman, marking a significant moment in the company's leadership. Max New York Life (MNYL) has the distinction of being the first private sector insurance company incorporated in India on 11 July 2000. Within a week of IRDAI allowing the incorporation of private sector insurance companies, MNYL was set up. Notably, on November 15, 2020, MNYL received certification of registration from IRDAI. The Board of Directors officially accepted the resignation of Analijt Singh. In a filing to the stock exchanges, Max Financial Services detailed the departure of Singh, who had played a key role in guiding the company. Singh explained in a letter that the timing of his retirement was linked to an understanding with Axis Bank regarding personal transition and succession planning as well as rotational appointment of chairman. The board unanimously approved the appointment of Rajiv Anand as the new chairman following the resignation of Analjit Singh. Anand, who was previously non-executive director of Max Life, was nominated for the role by Axis Bank Ltd. The move underlines the strategic collaboration between Max Life Insurance and Axis Bank.

5. 27th WAIPA World Investment Conference organized in New Delhi



The 27th World Association of Investment Promotion Agencies (WAIPA) World Investment Conference was launched on 11 December 2023 in New Delhi. The fourday (11 to 14 December 2023) World Investment Conference (WIC) is being organized at the India International Convention & Expo Center Yashobhoomi, New Delhi; This is the first time that the World Investment Conference is being organized in The theme of this year's conference is "Empowering Investors: Leading the IPA Future Growth" Is. The National Investment Promotion and Facilitation Agency of the Government of India and the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT) are organizing the conference. It is the largest world investment conference ever organized under the aegis of DPIIT. Union Commerce and Industry Minister Piyush Goyal will address the conference on the theme 'Role of trade and investment in the Decade of Action' on December 13. On this occasion, Union Minister Piyush Goyal will also launch the 'Experience India Centre' (EIC). This Experience India Center will showcase the best of India's innovations. It will primarily perform services through various technologies including virtual reality, augmented reality, interactive touch screens and projection mapping. The World Investment Conference, WAIPA's flagship annual event, serves as a platform for global investment promotion and innovation stakeholders. WAIPA's World Investment Conference is being held in India for the first time. More than 1000 people, 50 Investment Promotion Agencies (IPAs) and various multilateral agencies are participating in this conference. The World Association of Investment Promotion Agencies was founded in 1995 in Geneva as a non-governmental organization. Since 2015, WAIPA has been headquartered in Istanbul, Türkiye. WAIPA aims to develop economies through investment promotion agencies. WAIPA includes more than 120

agencies representing more than 100 countries as members.

6. Mohan Yadav has become the next CM of Madhya Pradesh.



Mohan Yaday has become the next CM of Madhya Pradesh. Mohan Yadav is MLA from Ujjain South. He has been the Education Minister in the former CM Shivraj Singh Chauhan government of the state. He has won the legislative elections for the third consecutive time. 163 BJP candidates have won on 230 member seats, while Congress is reduced to 66 seats. So one seat has gone to the account of Bharat Adivasi Party. The results of Madhya Pradesh Assembly elections were declared on December 3, but suspense remained regarding the post of CM. During this time, many candidates for the post of CM had also gone to Delhi and met Home Minister Amit Shah and National President of the party JP Nadda. But after about a week, Madhya Pradesh has got its new CM in the form of Mohan Yadav. Mohan Yadav is a big OBC face of BJP in Madhya Pradesh. His name has probably been announced keeping in view the 2024 Lok Sabha elections. Mohan Yadav's educational qualification is PhD. 58-year-old Mohan Yadav's political career sort of started in 1984 when he joined the Akhil Bharatiya Vidyarthi Parishad. He is also a member of RSS. He had contested elections from Ujjain South in 2013 and has been elected MLA from here for the third consecutive election. This time he defeated Congress candidate Chetan Prem Narayan Yadav by 12941 votes. Mohan Yadav got 95699 votes. The new Chief Minister of Madhya Pradesh, Mohan Yadav, started his political career from Akhil Bharatiya Vidyarthi Parishad, after which he stepped into Bharatiya Janata Yuva Morcha. Mohan Yadav, who was elected MLA from Ujjain thrice,

led BJP to victory every time. Mohan Yadav, MLA from Ujjain South and Higher Education Minister in Shivraj government, has been made the Chief Minister. Mohan Yadav's life was full of struggle. He joined Akhil Bharatiya Vidyarthi Parishad at a time when NSUI was in power in Ujjain. In his student life, Mohan Yadav registered victory by defeating powerful student leaders of Congress. After this Mohan Yadav kept winning continuously.

7. Supreme Court upheld the abrogation of Article 370



The Central Government's decision to remove Article 370 from Jammu and Kashmir will remain intact. The Constitution bench of 5 judges of the Supreme Court said on Monday – Article 370 was a temporary provision. It is clear from Articles 1 and 370 of the Constitution that Jammu and Kashmir is an integral part of India. All the provisions of the Indian Constitution can be applied there. The Center had removed Article 370 from Jammu and Kashmir on 5 August 2019. In its decision that came 4 years, 4 months and 6 days later, the court said, 'We consider the President's order issued to abrogate Article 370 as valid. We also maintain the validity of the decision to make Ladakh a Union Territory.' Along with this, the Supreme Court ordered to hold assembly elections in the state by 30 September 2024. The Modi government, in its second term, had abolished Article 370 on 5 August 2019. Also, the state was divided into two parts, Jammu-Kashmir and Ladakh. A total of 23 petitions were filed against this in the Supreme Court. A bench of 5 judges heard all the petitions together. The Constitution bench included Chief Justice DY Chandrachud, Justice BR Gavai, Justice Surya Kant, Justice Sanjay Kishan Kaul and Justice Sanjiv Khanna. The hearing before the bench, which lasted for 16 consecutive days, ended on September 5. After this the Supreme Court had reserved the decision. The

Supreme Court gave its verdict on the case after 96 days of hearing. CJI said that every decision taken by the Center cannot be challenged in the court. Doing this will spread anarchy. If the Centre's decision is creating any kind of difficulty, then only it can be challenged. The Supreme Court rejected the argument of the petitioners that during the President's rule, the Center cannot take any decision which cannot be changed.

8. Appointment of Damodar Rajanarasimha as Health Minister of Telangana



Telangana Chief Minister A Revanth Reddy appointed engineering graduate Damodar Rajanarasimha Silarapu as the state health minister. Given the traditional expectation of having a medical professional in charge of the health portfolio, this decision has sparked discussion and debate. Damodar Rajanarasimha, a veteran politician associated with the Indian National Congress (INC), started his political career in 1989. He secured a seat as a Member of the Legislative Assembly (MLA) from Andole constituency. Despite early setbacks, he demonstrated resilience and won elections in 2004 and 2009. Rajanarasimha's political rise reached new heights when he became a member of the cabinet of Chief Minister YS Rajasekhara Reddy in 2004. He initially served as the Minister of Primary Education and later took over as the Minister of Marketing and Warehousing in 2009. In 2011, he assumed the role of Deputy Chief Minister of united Andhra Pradesh and held this post till April 2014. In the recently concluded 2023 Telangana Assembly elections, Rajanarasimha won a significant victory in Andole constituency. He secured 1,14,147 votes (53.65%) and won by a huge margin of 28,193 votes. This electoral success strengthened his position and paved the way for his appointment as Health Minister. Despite his lack of medical background,

Rajnarasimha brings a wealth of experience and political acumen to his new role. Having obtained a Bachelor of Engineering degree from the College of Engineering, Osmania University in 1982, he is adept at solving complex issues and policy matters.
