1. Bhajan Lal Sharma, new CM of Rajasthan, Diya and Bairava became his deputies.



The name of Bhajan Lal Sharma as the new Chief Minister of Rajasthan has been announced on 12 December 2023. Bhajan Lal Sharma's name was approved unanimously in the Bharatiya Janata Party Legislative Party meeting. Also Diya Kumari and Prem Chand Bairwa have been made Deputy Chief Ministers of Rajasthan. Vasudev Devnani has been elected Speaker (Speaker) of Rajasthan Legislative Assembly. Bhajan Lal Sharma will be the 14th Chief Minister of Rajasthan in person. Earlier, Bharatiya Janata Party had sent Union Defense Minister Rainath Singh, Saroj Pandey and Vinod Tawde to Jaipur as observers. Bhajan Lal Sharma has been elected MLA for the first time from Sanganer Assembly of Jaipur. BJP gave ticket to Bhajan Lal Sharma in place of then MLA Ashok Lauhati in the 2023 assembly elections. Bhajan Lal Sharma defeated Pushpendra Bhardwaj of Congress by 48081 votes. Rajasthan election notification was issued by the Election Commission on 30 October 2023. Assembly elections were held in Rajasthan on 25 November and counting of votes was done on 3 December 2023. In the elections held on 199 seats out of total 200 seats of Rajasthan Assembly, Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) got 115 seats, Congress 69 seats, BSP 2 seats and others got 13 seats. A total of 13 Chief Ministers (in person) have taken oath in Rajasthan since 1949, starting from Hiralal Shastri. The person who has held the charge of Chief Minister for the longest period (more than 14 years) is Ashok Gehlot, who has been the Chief Minister of the state a total of three times. Whereas the second longest tenure is in the name of former Chief Minister Mohanlal

Sukhadia. He has become the Chief Minister of the state a total of four times for a short period. Vasundhara Raje Scindia of the Bharatiya Janata Party is the only woman Chief Minister of Rajasthan to remain in office for a full term of 5 years. She has been the Chief Minister of the state a total of two times.

The delegation includes Finance Minister Suresh Khanna and Industrial Development and Export Promotion Minister Nand Gopal Gupta Nandi. besides Infrastructure and Industrial Development Commissioner Manoj Kumar Singh and Secretary to Chief Minister Amit Singh. The ministers and officials going to attend the conference will present the model of fast pace of economic and industrial development of the state in about six and a half years on the global platform. 4. Travis Head becomes ICC Player of the Month



Australia's stormy opening batsman Travis Head, who played a century in the final of the ODI World Cup 2023 against India, won the title of ICC Player of the Month (November 2023). For this, Glenn Maxwell and Indian fast bowler Mohammed Shami were nominated along with Travis Head, but Head's performance in November overshadowed both these players and they achieved this honour. Although Shami and Maxwell also performed well in the month of November during the ODI World Cup 2023, but a single innings of Head ruined all their hard work. Travis Head was not available for the team in the initial matches of the ODI World Cup 2023 due to a finger injury, but when he returned, he made it memorable and played important innings for his team in the semi-finals and then the final, helping the team win. Played a big role. However, the Kangaroo team had shown so much trust in him that even after his injury, no other player was included in the team in his place. In the final match against India, Head had completely changed the game. The Kangaroo team had a target of 241 runs to win and the first 3 wickets of this team fell for 47 runs, but Head played an inning of 137 runs in 120 balls and gave the team victory by 6 wickets. Hit 4 sixes and 15 fours. Travis Head is only the second Australian men's player to be named the ICC 'Player of the Month'. Earlier, David Warner had won this award in November 2021. Travis Head scored 329 runs in 6

World Cup matches at an average of 54.83 and strike rate of 127.51. Till now, he has scored 2393 runs in 64 ODI matches at an average of 42.73.

5. India ranks seventh in Climate Change Performance Index



India ranked seventh in the Climate Change Performance Index this year, up one place from last time, and was among the best performers. This information has been given here in a report released during the global climate summit COP28. The index states that India is the world's most populous country, but per capita emissions are relatively low. The Climate Change Performance Index tracked the climate mitigation efforts of 63 countries and the European Union, which account for more than 90 percent of greenhouse gas emissions worldwide. India has received a high ranking in the greenhouse gas emissions and energy use categories in the index, but a moderate ranking in climate policy and renewable energy, as in the previous year. Our data shows that in the per capita greenhouse gas category, the country is on track to meet the well below two degrees Celsius standard, the report said based on the index. Although there appears to be a slight positive trend in the share of renewable energy in India, the trend is moving at a very slow pace. Climate Change Performance Index (CCPI) experts pointed out that India is trying to meet its Nationally Determined Contributions (NDCs) with clear long-term policies to promote renewable energy and domestic manufacturing of renewable energy components. Focuses on providing financial assistance. Despite this, India's growing energy needs are still met by heavy dependence on oil and gas as well as coal, the report said. "This dependence is a major source of greenhouse

gas emissions and causes severe air pollution, especially in cities," according to the report.

6. Nikhil Dey named '2023 International Anti-Corruption Champion' by US government



Indian social activist Nikhil Dey has been honored by the US government as the International Anti-Corruption Champion for 2023. The honor highlights his decadeslong commitment to empowering farmers and workers while exposing corruption in the delivery of government services. Dey is the co-founder of Mazdoor Kisan Shakti Sangathan (MKSS), a Rajasthan-based organization at the forefront of transparency and anti-corruption movements in India. For the past 35 years, Nikhil Dey has been a staunch advocate of policy reforms aimed at empowering workers in India. The US State Department acknowledged his efforts in bringing to light official corruption, particularly examples such as underpayment of workers on official projects. Dey's work focuses on creating empowerment campaigns for farmers and workers and targeting corruption in the delivery of essential government services. One of Dey's notable contributions is introducing public audit through the MKSS. Local authorities now require communities to report on how and where resources are spent, allowing citizens to ask investigative questions. This practice, started by Day's organization, has spread across India, encouraging citizens to take a leading role in holding officials accountable. United States Secretary of State Antony Blinken praised Nikhil Dey for his work with marginalized underprivileged and populations, particularly in Rajasthan. Day and his organization have played a vital role in helping communities seeking access to essential services and rights, including education, health care, fair wages and better working

conditions. The leadership of MKSS has been instrumental in starting the struggle for minimum wage and transparency in the state.

7. 'Peaky Blinders' actor Benjamin Zephaniah dies of brain tumor at age 65



Peaky Blinders' actor and poet Benjamin Zephaniah has died at the age of 65. He played the role of Jeremiah Jesus on the popular show. Benjamin was a true pioneer and innovator, he gave so much to the world. Through an amazing career encompassing a vast collection of poems, literature, music, television and radio, Benjamin has left us a delightful and brilliant legacy. Born and raised in Birmingham, England, Zephaniah's journey into the literary world began when he moved to London. At the age of 22, he made a significant mark with the publication of his first book of poetry titled "Pain Rhythm" in 1980. This marked the beginning of an illustrious career that spanned several decades. Over the years, Benjamin Zephaniah contributed greatly to the literary scene. He wrote a total of 14 poetry books, including notable works such as "The Dread Affair" in 1985, where he critically examined the British legal system. His keen observations extended to global affairs, as evidenced by his thoughts on a trip to Palestine captured in "Rasta Time in Palestine" (1990). Beyond poetry, Zephaniah ventured into novels and plays, demonstrating his versatility as a storyteller. In 2018, he wrote his autobiography, "The Life and Rhymes of Benjamin Zephaniah," giving readers a glimpse into his extraordinary life. Benjamin Zephaniah's influence was not limited to the written word; He also left an indelible mark on the television industry. His most prominent role was that of preacher Jeremiah Jesus in the widely acclaimed series "Peaky

Blinders," where he appeared in 14 episodes over the show's six seasons. In addition to this iconic role, Zephaniah graced other television productions including "EastEnders," "The Bill," and "Zen Motoring."

8. Indian Navy conducts bi-annual 'Prasthan' exercise off Mumbai coast



The Indian Navy in collaboration with various defence, state and civilian agencies recently conducted an extensive two-phase exercise named 'Prasthan' in the Offshore Development Area off the Mumbai coast. This exercise, conducted every six months, is important in validating and refining the measures and procedures aimed at addressing various contingencies that may arise in oil production platforms. The first phase of the exercise focused on simulating security emergencies including potential terrorist attacks and bomb threats involving improvised explosive devices (IEDs). Oil and Natural Gas Corporation (ONGC)'s R12A (Ratna) platform, located approximately 83 km off Mumbai port, serves as the setting for these simulations. On receiving the fake threats, the Flag Officer Commanding-in-Chief, Western Naval Command, Mumbai and Commander-in-Chief (Coastal Defence), West activated necessary contingency plans. The Crisis Management Committee (CMC), comprising senior officials from various defence, state and civilian agencies, convened at the Indian Navy's operations center to facilitate a coordinated response to the emergency. The CMC assessed various aspects of the emergency and initiated coordinated action by concerned agencies following established standard operating procedures. The Indian Navy, in collaboration with the Indian Air Force, deployed anti-sabotage teams to neutralize the security threats at the affected oil

platform. The first phase also addressed contingencies such as terrorist infiltration, bomb threats, man overboard, medical evacuation of platform crew and oil spills. The second phase of the exercise focused on responding to contingencies such as a fire on an oil platform and assisting a disabled vessel in the offshore development zone. Multiple assets including ships and helicopters from the Indian Navy, Indian Air Force, Indian Coast Guard, ONGC, Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas and Director General of Shipping were deployed for this phase.
