

1. Reliance partners with DBS Bank for biogas initiative



Reliance Industries has formed a strategic partnership with DBS Bank India to set up a financing program targeted at farmers and aggregators. The primary objective of this collaboration is to effectively manage crop residue and utilize it in the production of Compressed Biogas (CBG). Reliance Industries, a conglomerate at the forefront of aggressively pursuing opportunities in non-fossil fuels, is actively engaged in the production of CBG. This innovative approach positions CBG as a viable alternative to conventional fuels such as compressed natural gas (CNG) and other fossil fuels. Farmers often resort to burning agricultural residues due to the lack of tools, infrastructure and logistics required for proper processing. Reliance Industries has identified this challenge and has enlisted DBS Bank India as its finance partner to address the financial aspects of sustainable waste management. DBS Bank India in a statement stressed the need to involve farmers from different states to realize the full potential of CBG. The bank sees CBG not only as an alternative fuel to meet growing domestic gas demand, but also as a way to benefit the local agricultural economy by providing farmers with an additional revenue stream and helping them avoid penalties associated with residue burning. Also seen as a means. Reliance Industries is actively pursuing its green energy commitment, launching a nationwide program for biogas facilities. The initial facility in Barabanki, UP is estimated to reduce carbon emissions by 40,000 tonnes annually. With plans to set up 100 CBG plants in five years, the initiative aims to utilize over 5.5 million tonnes of agricultural residues, contributing to an annual reduction of 2 million tonnes of carbon emissions.

2. Arjun Award to Mohammed Shami, Satwik-Chirag pair nominated for Khel Ratna Award



Fast bowler Mohammed Shami, who performed brilliantly in the ODI World Cup, has been nominated for the Arjuna Award, while badminton men's doubles pair Satwiksairaj Rankireddy and Chirag Shetty have been nominated for the Major Dhyan Chand Khel Ratna Award. Thirty-three-year-old fast bowler Shami had performed brilliantly in the ODI World Cup. India lost to Australia in the final of this tournament. According to Sports Ministry sources, the Board of Control for Cricket in India (BCCI) made a special request to include Shami's name in the list. Earlier his name was not included in the list of players nominated for the country's second highest sports award. Shami took the most wickets in the ODI World Cup. He had taken 24 wickets in only seven matches. After being out of the first four matches, when Shami got a chance, he took full advantage of it. He can now play in the upcoming two-Test series against South Africa. Apart from Shami, 16 other players have also been nominated for the Arjuna Award. These include men's hockey players Krishna Bahadur Pathak and Sushila Chanu, archers Ojas Praveen Deotale and Aditi Gopichand Swamy, boxer Mohammad Hussamuddin, chess player R Vaishali, golfer Diksha Dagar, shooter Aishwarya Pratap Singh Tomar, wrestler Anant Panghal and table tennis player Ayhika Mukherjee. . Ganesh Prabhakaran (Mallakhamb), Mahavir Saini (Para Athletics), Lalit Kumar (Wrestling), RB Ramesh (Chess) and Shivendra Singh (Hockey) have been nominated for the Dronacharya Award for coaches. Kavita (Kabaddi). Manjusha Kanwar (Badminton) and Vineet Kumar Sharma (Hockey) have been nominated for the Dhyan Chand Lifetime Award. The Sports Ministry has constituted a 12-member

committee to decide this year's Major Dhyan Chand Khel Ratna Award and Arjuna Award.

3. Statue of Tamil poet Thiruvalluvar inaugurated in France



The statue of Tamil poet and philosopher Thiruvalluvar was unveiled in Sergi, France on December 10, 2023. Thiruvalluvar was a great saint of South India. He is also called Kabir of South India. Thiruvalluvar had composed 'Tirukkural' or 'Kural' in Sangam literature. Thirukkural has been compared to the great books of the world's major religions. 4. IPL 2024: Brand value of IPL crosses 10 billion dollars



The total combined brand value of the Indian Premier League (IPL) has crossed the \$10 billion mark. As of now, the brand value of IPL is \$10.7 billion, while in 2022 it was \$8.4 billion, thus registering a growth of 28%. A report by brand valuation consultancy Brand Finance said the overall brand value of the IPL has increased by 433 per cent since its launch in 2008. It said the IPL's significant growth is attributed to factors including the \$6.2 billion (Rs 48,390 crore) media rights deal, the increase in the central pool of IPL revenue, the inclusion of two franchise teams, and Covid-19. Full stadium attendance to return in 2023 after pandemic. Five-time champions Mumbai Indians have emerged as the most valuable IPL brand with \$87 million, followed by five-time winners Chennai Super Kings (CSK), who are now the second most valuable brand with \$81 million. Other franchises in the top five list include twotime winners Kolkata Knight Riders (KKR) and Royal Challengers Bangalore (RCB) with \$78.6 million and \$69.8 million respectively. IPL 2022 winners Gujarat Titans (GT) witnessed a massive rise in their brand value ranking with a 38 per cent increase to the fifth position, a huge jump from the eighth position last year. Lucknow Super Giants (LSG) is ranked eighth with a brand value of \$47 million and is now the fastest growing IPL brand with a growth of 48 percent. The report said that despite starting from a relatively low base, LSG has made substantial progress in the valuation landscape.

5. Golden Globe Awards Nominations 2024



The glitz and glamor of Hollywood took center stage as the nominees for the 81st annual Golden Globe Awards were announced, setting the tone for the highly anticipated 2024 awards season. The unveiling not only showcased the industry's top talent, but also marked a significant moment in the history of the Golden Globes, a ceremony that has undergone significant changes in recent times. "Barbie" and Christopher Nolan's "Oppenheimer" emerged as the frontrunners, both garnering critical attention with 10 and 8 nominations, respectively. The rare confluence of these blockbuster films in the same weekend led to memes and Halloween costumes, which contributed to a turbocharged box office haul. In the television categories, HBO's "Succession" remained on top with nine nominations for its final season. "The Bear" and "Only Murders in the Building" received five nods each. The article highlights the competitive races in both the drama and comedy categories. Netflix emerged as the leading media company with 28 nominations, showcasing its diverse lineup of series and films, including "Maestro," "The Crown" and "The Diplomat." Warner Bros. Discovery follows closely behind with 27 nominations, buoyed by recognition for "Barbie," "Succession" and "Barry." Despite earning rave reviews, Ava DuVernay's "Origins" and Michael Mann's "Ferrari" were notably absent from the nominations. "The Color Purple" failed to take home the best musical or comedy award and the "Frasier" reboot also took home no honors. There are notable changes at this year's Golden Globes, including six nominees per category instead of five. Two new awards have been introduced to celebrate box office achievements and stand-up comedy performances, recognizing films like "John

Wick: Chapter 4" and stand-up specials from Trevor Noah, Amy Schumer and Ricky Gervais Is.

6. IPL 2024: Kolkata Knight Riders again handed over captaincy to Shreyas Iyer

7. iPhone maker Foxconn will make big investment in Karnataka



Taiwan-based giant Foxconn, responsible for assembling about 70% of iPhones globally, will invest an additional 139.11 billion rupees (\$1.67 billion) in Karnataka state. In a significant move, Taiwan-based giant Foxconn, responsible for assembling about 70% of iPhones globally, is set to invest an additional Rs 139.11 billion (\$1.67 billion) in the state of Karnataka. The decision highlights Foxconn's ongoing efforts to diversify production away from China, driven by disruptions caused by the COVID-19 pandemic and geopolitical tensions. Foxconn, the world's largest contract manufacturing company, has been expanding rapidly in India in the last one year. Notably, in the face of uncertainties and disruptions, the decision to diversify production is in line with global trends of companies seeking to reduce dependence on a single manufacturing facility. In August, Foxconn had already announced a major investment of \$600 million in two projects within Karnataka. These projects are aimed at manufacturing casing components for iPhones and chipmaking equipment, demonstrating the company's commitment to establishing a strong manufacturing ecosystem in the southern state. One of the most notable aspects of Foxconn's expansion plans is its intention to start iPhone manufacturing in Karnataka by April 2024. This ambitious project is likely to create approximately 50,000 jobs in the region, which will contribute significantly to employment opportunities.

8. Debt of 12 Indian states likely to exceed 35% of GSDP by FY 2024



Twelve Indian states, including Punjab and West Bengal, are estimated to have debt exceeding 35% of GSDP by FY2024, prompting a warning from the RBI. In India's fiscal outlook, a worrying trend has emerged as the debt of twelve states is projected to exceed 35% of their Gross State Domestic Product (GSDP) by the end of fiscal year 2023-24. This revelation, detailed in the latest annual publication of the Reserve Bank of India (RBI), points to possible fiscal mismanagement and raises concerns about the fragile fiscal position of these states. The states that have attracted RBI's attention for fiscal mismanagement include Arunachal Pradesh, Bihar, Goa, Himachal Pradesh, Kerala, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, Punjab, Rajasthan and West Bengal. The central bank's annual publication cautions against additional allocations for nonqualifying goods, services, subsidies, transfers and guarantees, as such moves could jeopardize the hardwon fiscal consolidation achieved over the past two years. Can. These twelve states have collectively estimated their fiscal deficit in the current financial year to exceed 4% of their respective GSDP, indicating a challenging fiscal scenario. The RBI has emphasized the potential disruptions it may cause and urged caution in managing fiscal policies. Interestingly, none of the Union Territories, including Jammu and Kashmir, Delhi and Puducherry, have estimated their debt to be more than 35% of GSDP.
