

## 1. Textile Ministry unveils “Paat-Mitro” application for the convenience of jute farmers



Ministry of Textiles, in its continuous efforts to support and empower jute farmers, has launched “Paat-Mitro” mobile application. Developed by Jute Corporation of India Limited (JCI), this application is an important step towards providing essential information about Minimum Support Price (MSP) and agronomy to jute farmers. The launch took place during the ‘Jute Seminar’, where Smt. Rachna Shah, Secretary, Ministry of Textiles, inaugurated the application, which is available in six languages. The primary objective of the Paat-Mitro application is to empower jute farmers by providing important information about Minimum Support Price (MSP) and agronomic practices. The application is available in six languages, ensuring accessibility for a diverse group of users. All the functionalities of the application are provided free of cost to the users, making it easily accessible to jute farmers. Apart from MSP and agronomic practices, the application also includes features like jute gradation parameters, farmer-centric schemes like 'Jute-ICARE', Contains information on weather forecast, locations of JCI procurement centers and procurement policies. Farmers can track payment status of raw jute sold to JCI under MSP operation. Incorporating the latest technology, the application includes a chatbot to address farmers' queries and provide real-time assistance. JCI was established in 1971 as an official agency by the Government of India with the specific objective of providing Minimum Support Price (MSP) to jute cultivators. JCI acts as the implementing agency for various projects undertaken by the Government of India to increase the cultivation of jute crop and improve the lives of jute growers.

## 2. World Bank provides \$300 million loan to Tamil Nadu to help 21 urban local bodies



The World Bank's Board of Executive Directors has approved a new program to support Tamil Nadu and provide more and better access to water and sewerage services to nearly 2 million people in the cities. The \$300 million Tamil Nadu Climate Resilient Urban Development Program will help 21 urban local bodies (ULBs) update their distribution systems and provide quality and efficient water supply and sewerage services to consumers, a World Bank release said. The \$300 million loan from the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development (IBRD) will use the blended financing instrument of Programs-for-Results (PfOR) with Investment Project Financing (IPF) to directly link the distribution of funds to the achievement of results. Could. technical support. The program loan has a maturity period of 32 years and a grace period of 7 years. Tamil Nadu is one of the most urbanized states of India and is facing increasing impacts of climate-related shocks such as floods and droughts. For its rapidly growing population, access to services like water and sanitation is essential for more climate-resilient cities. "By 2030, about 70 percent of India's new jobs will be created in cities and more than 18 million people will move to cities," said Auguste Tano Koume, World Bank Country Director for India. "As hubs for economic growth, it is important to strengthen their capacity to cope with the impacts of climate change and ensure continuity in basic service delivery." Apart from helping households gain better access to water supply, the program will assist ULBs in increasing the areas designated for green spaces and parks.

## 3. India's foreign exchange reserves reach 20-month high

India's foreign exchange reserves hit a 20-month high of \$616 billion in the week ended December 15. Recent data from the Reserve Bank of India shows that this is the highest level since March 25, 2022. Reserves increased by \$9 billion during the week, which is the second largest weekly increase in the current financial year. Total reserves increased due to increase in foreign currency assets. It increased by \$8 billion during the week. Indranil Pan, Chief Economist at Yes Bank, said, 'The main reason for the increase in foreign exchange reserves could be the fall in the dollar index.' The rupee strengthened by 0.4 percent due to the fall in the dollar index after the results of the US Federal Reserve meeting. Due to this, the hope of increasing the rates has ended and there is a possibility of reduction in interest rates thrice in the next year i.e. 2024. America decided to maintain key rates at 5.25 to 5.50 percent for the third consecutive time. According to the Reserve Bank, the value of gold reserves increased by \$ 446 million to \$ 47.577 billion. Special Drawing Rights (SDR) increased by \$ 135 million to \$ 18.323 billion. Total reserves stood at \$607 billion in the week ending December 8. One of the major reasons for the increase in foreign exchange reserves is the increase in foreign investment. There has been an increase in foreign portfolio investment in the country after the Federal Reserve's decision not to increase interest rates and indications of cutting interest rates in the year 2024. There is a possibility that there may be further increase in foreign investment in the new year. In October 2021, foreign exchange reserves had reached the level of \$645 billion, after which there was a big decline. Now foreign exchange reserves are \$30 billion away from their old high. Due to the surge in dollar inflow, the rupee has strengthened against the dollar in the currency market. On December 22, the rupee

strengthened by 14 paise and closed at 83.14 against one dollar.

All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), Confederation of Indian Industry (CII), Association of Indian Universities (AIU) According to the report published by talent assessment agency Wheebox in collaboration with Google and Tagged, Kerala is the second state with the highest employment resources among the 18-21 age group. The report surveyed 3.88 lakh youth through the National Employability Test conducted across the country. The report shows that employability in India has improved as 51.25 percent of the youth surveyed are employable with the required skills. Among cities where men and women prefer to work equally regardless of age, Kochi ranks second and Thiruvananthapuram fourth in the country. ## 8. Railways will install panic switches at 117 stations



Central Railway General Manager Ram Karan Yadav has said that panic switches will be installed at 117 railway stations. In his first press conference after taking charge, Yadav said that Central Railways will install these panic switches at 117 stations of its network. The panic switch will alert Railway Protection Force (RPF) personnel. In case of any emergency, passengers can press these switches to seek help from RPF. Central Railway has signed an MoU with RailTel for installation of the switches. These will be such switches, when pressed, the RPF control will get an alert. After which CCTV will be checked and help will be sent to the passengers immediately. The process of installing the switches is expected to be completed within a year. At a press conference, Central Railway General Manager Ram Karan Yadav said that an emergency talkback system and CCTV cameras will also be installed on all women coaches in Mumbai local trains by March 2024. As of now, out of 771 women coaches, 512 coaches are already fitted with emergency talkback system and 421 coaches are fitted with CCTV. Central Railway operates around 1850 suburban services, 145 DEMU-MEMU trains and 371 Mail-Express trains in its Mumbai network, including five Vande Bharat Express trains.
